#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION;**

That the Board of Commissioners Receive and File Petition from Residents in the Neighborhood of 214 Trinity Street.

#### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION**

In coordination with ADMH and Turning Point; YCH held a community meeting with the residents in the area of the 214 Trinity Street property on August 27, 2008 at 6:00pm. Representatives from the YCH's architects office were also on hand to provide color selection choices and to talk about landscaping options with residents. Staff from the different agencies and the architect provided attendees with an overview of the project and gathered input from residents regarding concerns they might have so that staff could consider those issues during the development of house rules and operations policies for the home. Staff also committed to a follow up newsletter outlining the construction schedule and milestones for the home as well as to answer some questions that could not be answered at the meeting that evening.

The purpose of the housing is for affordable housing for persons capable of independent living. It was stressed to residents that these persons are voluntary participants in mental health services and persons who have violent histories, those with criminal histories, those on parole and registered sex offenders are not eligible for housing. In addition, it was stressed to the neighborhood that the homes are sober living facilities and that there is weekly oversight of the home.

At the conclusion of the meeting, a signed petition from the residents in the neighborhood was presented to YCH Executive Director, Lisa A. Baker, which is attached for your consideration.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no anticipated financial impact at this time.

## **CONCLUSION**

Staff recommends receipt and file of petition from residents of the neighborhood of 214 Trinity Street dated August 26, 2008.
