The Yolo County Division of Integrated Waste Management has been working with Waste Management, Inc., your local hauling company, to enhance solid waste and recycling collection services in your neighborhood.

County staff set out to achieve the most environmentally sound program while also reducing rates for residents. We are happy to say that we achieved both of these goals.

On the reverse side of this letter you will find detailed information about your collection enhancements Under the ordinance each resident outlined in the corresponding maps (dense areas) would need to dispose of their trash weekly either by continuing subscription with Waste Management, Inc. or by self hauling their waste to a proper disposal facility.

#### **Collection Enhancements**

#### **New Curbside Services:**

- 64-gallon weekly trash collection
- 96-gallon every other week collection of Single Stream Recycling (see list to right)
- Annual bulky item collection service of up to 4 cubic yards of bulky materials plus one appliance

Rate: \$23.60 / month \$2.18/mo. savings from current rates (For all of the services listed above)



#### **Current Curbside Services:**

96-gallon weekly trash collection

Rate: \$25.78 / month

- Aluminum Cans

(Ex. Cat Food Cans, Soup Cans)

- Plastic Milk and Water Jugs
- Mixed Plastic Bottles and Containers (Ex. Yogurt Container, Butter Tub, Shampoo Bottle, Lotion Bottle)

NO: Styrofoam or Plastic Bags

#### **Glass**

Any Color Glass Bottles and Jars
 (Ex. Pickle Jar, Juice Bottle, Jelly Jar and Wine Bottle)

NO: Window glass or glassware

#### **Paper and Cardboard**

- Cardboard
- Paperboard
   (Ex. Cereal Box, Kleenex Box, Paper Towel Roll)
- Loose Newspaper and Inserts
- Magazines, Catalogs & Glossy Paper
- Junk Mail
- Envelopes with and without windows
- Any Color Office or Notebook Paper
- Paper Bags
- Sticky Notes
