Carts are used for garbage, organics, and recyclables. Please set out carts provided by Recology Davis by 6am on your service day. Full carts may not weigh more than 200 pounds. Please be careful not to exceed weight limits. Fees may be charged for damage to overweight carts.

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Yolo County residents can bring their hazardous waste, electronics, and universal waste to the household hazardous waste (HHW) Drop-Off Days at the Yolo County Central Landfill for free every Friday and Saturday from 7:30am – 3:30pm.

## BULKY WASTE LANDFILL COUPON:

Each single-family household and multi-family residential unit will receive a landfill coupon in May and October valid for the entire calendar month. Each landfill coupon entitles the customer up to eight bulky items for disposal at the Yolo County Landfill.

## SENIOR/ DISABLED BULKY WASTE COLLECTION:

Single-family customers in a household where all inhabitants are 65 years of age or older, or have a disability can receive up to two Bulky Waste Collection service events per year at the curbside at no extra charge to the customer.

## LOW INCOME DISCOUNTS:\*

Any single-family customer household that has been authorized for low income assistance by Yolo County may qualify for a twenty percent (20%) discount.

## ASSISTED SERVICE:\*

Disabled residents who have applied for Assisted Service through Yolo County and have been authorized for such collection will receive the following. Drivers shall walk up, retrieve carts from garage or fence line, service carts, and return carts to original location.

- containers must be empty
  - remove caps & lids, place in cart separately
  - labels are okay
  - all rigid plastics #1-#7
  - all plastic containers
  - food & beverage glass bottles and jars
  - aluminum, tin & steel cans
  - aluminum foil
  - empty aerosol & paint cans
- plastic bags, film or wrap
  - plastic foam
  - packing peanuts
  - tires or hoses
  - light bulbs
  - mirrors
  - window glass
  - auto glass
  - dishes & pans
  - scrap metals
  - porcelain & ceramic

- fruits & vegetables
  - eggshells
  - bio-bags with food waste
  - meat, poultry & seafood
  - dairy products (no liquids)

  - waxed milk cartons, etc
  - greasy pizza boxes
