Subject: Rescission of Previous Travel Advisory and Reversion to State Travel Advisory

Effective immediately, the Yolo County Health Advisory regarding Self-Quarantine after Travel, originally issued on November 19, 2020 and amended on December 18, 2020, is hereby rescinded. The local guidance is being rescinded to simplify recommendations and reduce confusion among Yolo County residents and visitors created by separate local, State, and federal travel guidance documents.

Residents of and visitors to Yolo County should now follow guidance provided by the California Department of Public Health in its revised April 2, 2021 <u>Travel Advisory</u>.

The revised CDPH Travel Advisory in turn refers to <u>CDC travel guidance</u>. It is important to note that CDC guidance for <u>domestic</u> and <u>international</u> travel differ. A major change from CDPH's prior Travel Advisory is the provision of separate guidance for individuals who are fully vaccinated. Fully vaccinated persons are no longer asked to quarantine after domestic or international travel. In addition, fully vaccinated domestic travelers do not need to test before or after travel unless they develop symptoms or their destination requires it. Fully vaccinated international travelers should continue to test 3-5 days after return to the United States.
