- Board of Supervisors appoint one member from each of the 5 Supervisorial Districts
- 2 community members appointed as at-large representatives
- Include representation from vulnerable, marginalized, and underserved communities
- Voting members
- Total = 7 (5+2)

Technical Lead

- Board of Supervisors appoint one member to serve as the technical lead or subject matter expert from the field of sustainability and climate change
- Recruited by County Staff, approved by Board

• Total = 1

Community Mobilization Lead

- Board of Supervisors appoint one member to serve as the community engagement lead or subject matter expert from the field public engagement to ensure representation and participation by vulnerable, marginalized, and underserved communities.
- Recruited by County Staff, approved by Board

• Total = 1

Board Liaisons

- The Board of Supervisors will appoint two of its members to serve as liaisons to the YCCAC
- Non-voting liaison status
