Dear Judge Cortés:

The City Council is in receipt of the Grand Jury's report that published six investigative reports with a combined total of 30 findings and 26 recommendations. Pursuant to Penal Code 933 and 933.05, the Grand Jury requested that the City Council respond to Finding F7 and Recommendation R4. As requested the City Council has completed the response form provided by the Grand Jury (see attached) and provides additional support for such responses below.

GRAND JURY FINDINGS

F7. The City of Woodland's future projections of retiree medical and pension costs have not been posted on their website as of May 2020.

We agree with this finding. The City of Woodland does provide financial information on its website via its "OpenGov" transparency portal. While the portal provides past years data and current fiscal year financial data, it does not provide a simple chart showing three years past and three projected years (look back, look forward) as the Grand Jury recommended.

GRAND JURY RECOMMENDATIONS

Stallary

R4. By January 1, 2021 the City of Woodland should post updated information regarding projections of future retiree medical and pension costs on its website.

We agree with this recommendation and financial data regarding retiree medical and pension costs has been posted as a separate simple chart on our website. In addition, we will begin to include this chart in our annual budget book that is posted on our website starting with the Fiscal Year 2021/22 when it is ready and published.
