## Help Yolo County Achieve Carbon Negative Status by 2030

**(Woodland, CA)** – Yolo County is seeking eight additional members of the Yolo County Climate Action Commission to advise Yolo County on immediate actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, address equity issues, and update the Yolo County Climate Action Plan. The Yolo County Board of Supervisors created the Commission earlier this year to achieve the goals listed in Resolution No. 20-114, which declared a climate crisis requiring an immediate mobilization of resources to effect a just transition towards an inclusive, equitable, sustainable, and resilient local economy while also supporting and advocating for regional, national, and international efforts necessary to reverse the climate, social justice, and economic crises. Commission members will engage directly with County partners, staff, and the Board of Supervisors to help develop the policies and actions to achieve these goals.

The Commission is comprised of eleven members, with five members directly appointed by members of the Board of Supervisors, one from each district, and an additional two members directly appointed by the previously appointed five members from the County at-large. There are four current vacancies, for multiple categories of membership, including: one member from Supervisorial District 3, one technical lead in the field of climate change or sustainability, and one environmental justice lead. Additionally, two at-large community members will be appointed by the five members who are appointed by the County Supervisors. Two additional climate scientists or subject matter experts may be appointed by the Commission to serve after the recruitment of the original nine members concludes.
