

Funding for rebates is first-come first-serve and is not guaranteed. Please check funding availability by contacting the CSA Manager prior to submitting an application.

There is a limit of one rebate per utility account.

Grass removal program

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a Wild Wings property owner. Projects are NOT retroactive. Projects underway or completed prior to pre-inspection are not eligible.
- Maximum conversion rebate is \$500 per household at \$1.25 per square foot of grass converted up to 400 square feet.
- County staff will visit the site and verify the work.
- Receipts will be verified.
- Checks may take up to 90 days from the date it is approved.

Weather-based irrigation controllers

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a Wild Wings property owner. This program is NOT retroactive. Purchases prior to the Board of Supervisors approval of the program are not eligible.
- Maximum rebate of \$150.00
- Only weather based irrigation controllers that have an EPA WaterSense Label are eligible for a rebate.
- The rebate is the purchase price plus tax or \$150, whichever is less.
- Applications must be received within 90 days of purchase; Applicant must submit a copy of the sales receipt.
- Applicant must submit photo(s) of their installed weather-based irrigation controller.
- Units are subject to inspection for program compliance. Failure to comply may forfeit rebate.

Flume rebate

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a Wild Wings property owners. Purchases are NOT retroactive.
- Maximum rebate of \$100. The purchase price of the device is \$199.
- Flume is a smart home water monitor that can be self-installed, according to the website. It detects leaks as well as monitor/manage water usage. An app is downloaded onto a mobile device and a homeowner must place the sensor on the water meter. More information on Flume can be found at www.flumewater.com
