Planning. Lindsey will be asking for the Committee to consider and approve sending out the revised version for Old Willowbank residents' information.

- 8. Waste Removal Cost Increases—Committee Member Joanne Roy, in response to questions on recent rate increases, will present information on whether the new rates are consistent with what residents were told two years ago when the new contract with Davis Recology was executed with Yolo County.

  Office would be pleased to receive additional historical information. McCapes
  gathered such information and it has been sent to the Supervisor's Office.

On a related matter, McCapes will query Members and the public at Tuesday night's meeting on whether there is interest in going further in the gathering of historical information on Old Willowbank for the benefit of its residents.
