2010 District Populations

The County of Yolo last redistricted in 2011 through a county-based process with a supporting Advisory Redistricting Commission comprised of Yolo County residents. The populations of each district at that time were based on the 2010 Decennial Census.

As the following table shows, utilizing the American Community Survey (ACS) data from the 2006-2010 vintage which would be used in the 2011 redistricting, there was no district which was 50% or more of any single Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP) ethnic/racial subset.

Population Growth and Estimated Deviations

The US Census has released in a "legacy format" the data from the decennial census, identifying the whole count of persons and where they resided as of April 1, 2020. Redistricting Partners has concluded the work of placing this data into the census blocks, block groups, and tracts.¹

This data represents the whole population data prior to a state required reallocation of prison population that will be conducted by the Statewide Database at UC Berkeley. This adjusted data will be completed in the coming weeks and updated counts will be provided at that time.

Based on this data, the County has grown by 15,554 residents, or 7.7%, since the last decennial census. This is slightly higher than the state's population change of 6.1%.

¹ These counts are based on the 2020 Census geography. There may be slight differences as many census blocks were consolidated.

The largest population increase was seen in District 1, which gained 5,660 residents. All five districts saw an increase in population since the last decennial census.

2020 Census Populations and Growth

With a total population of 216,403, the ideal population for any district would be 43,281. The seat with the largest population is District 1 at 46,041 (+6.4%) and the district with the smallest population is District 5 at 40,362 (-6.7%), placing the County with a total deviation of 13.1%, over the 10% required deviation range.

Based on CVAP, the County's adult eligible voter population has grown by 10.9% - slightly faster than the County's 7.7% population growth.

The CVAP data has been finalized for this redistricting cycle. This data shows significant change in the ethnic composition of districts over the last decade. Overall, CVAP population growth was 28.5% among Latinos, 11.8% among Asians, and 32.4% among African Americans within the County. One of the most notable ethnic and racial changes includes the Latino CVAP population surpassing 40% in District 5.


