6. DISCUSSION ITEMS/PARKS DIVISION STAFF UPDATES

<u>Cache Creek Campground:</u> The campground is still operating at 65% capacity (29 reservable sites out of 45), and all group sites are still closed. Campground will close at the end of the month.

<u>OHV Planning Grant:</u> Staff is currently editing the final Background Report/Market Analysis (Phase I) and the Feasibility Study (Phase II). We expect to take the final reports to the Board in October to seek further direction on either OHV park option.

<u>County Road 40/Low Water Bridge:</u> Work has begun work on the CR40 Bridge over Cache Creek Replacement Project. Bridge removal was completed last week (~September 10). Drilling for foundation work is expected to begin next week (~September 20). Completion target is mid-2022.
