BUILD A KIT

- 1. BASIC KIT survival for 1-2 weeks
 - water, food (for example Meals Ready to Eat)
 - manual can opener
 - flashlight/batteries/crank radio
 - whistle
 - · first aid kit
 - cell phone with charger
 - prescribed and over-the-counter medications, face masks
 - toilet paper, menstrual and incontinent supplies
 - towels, washcloths, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb
 - plastic sheeting and duct tape, plastic garbage bags
 - wrench or pliers (to turn off utilities)
 - change of clothing, warm jacket
 - paper plates, plastic utensils
 - important family documents, including health related paperwork; local maps
- 2. GO-KIT portable, survival for 1-3 days
 - The 6 P's
 - PHONE with charger, phone #s
 - PRESCRIPTIONS, nonprescription medications, vitamins, eyeglasses, hearing aids
 - PERSONAL COMPUTERS (hard drives and disks) and PERSONAL TOILETRIES
 - PLASTIC, credit/ATM cards, cash, maps of the area, other documentation
 - PHOTOS, other irreplaceable memorabilia
 - PERSONS/PETS don't forget
 - · Water and food for 2 days; manual can opener
 - flashlight/batteries/crank radio/whistle
 - · first aid kit, emergency blanket
- 3. ANIMAL KIT for pets
 - food and water
 - medicines and medical records
 - · collar or harness with ID tag, rabies tag and leash
 - crate or pet carrier, familiar items
 - sanitation bags

4. DOCUMENTATION KIT - pertinent documents

- · driver's license
- passport
- · social security card
- · birth certificate
- marriage/divorce papers
- home titles/deeds
- car/boat/RV registration
- room by room inventory (take pictures)
- contact information (family, doctor, dentist, landlord)
- financial records (utility bills/credit card bills, bank statements, insurance policies, investment records, IRS information, pay stubs/employer benefit records, wills/trusts, financial and medical powers of attorney
- medical records (health insurance cards, list of medications/ allergies)
- computer files (back up to cloud service)

5. ADDITIONAL EMERGENCY SUPPLIES

- comfort items (deck of cards, paperback book)
- · sleeping bag, warm blanket
- · matches in waterproof container
- · directions how to turn off water, electricity, natural gas in home
- keep gas tank in car 1/2 full; keep electric cars charged

6. MAINTAIN YOUR KIT

- Keep canned food in cool, dry place; replace if expired
- · Store boxed food in tightly closed plastic/metal containers
- · Rethink needs every year & update kit as family needs change
- Replace water every few months so it doesn't expire
- Use daylight savings time or your birthday as reminders to:
 - update kit;
 - · check flashlight batteries
 - replace items that have expired

7. MOVING YOUR SUPPLY KIT

- Make sure you can easily move your supply kit
- Test the mobility of your basic supply kit before an emergency occurs
- 8. STORAGE LOCATIONS prepare a kit for home, work, vehicles
