WHAT IS A COMMUNITY OF INTEREST?

A Community of Interest is a group of people in the same geographically definable area who share common social and economic interests. Some examples of Communities of Interest are:

- Senior citizens
- LGBTQIA+ communities
- College students living near campus
- People who live downtown or in a neighborhood
- Dog park community
- Residents who share a common language
- People that use the same transportation systems

1. Does your community have a shared culture, characteristics, or bond?
2. Is your community geographic in nature? Is your community able to be mapped? Is there density within your community? *Rural people represent*
3. Describe your community's relationship with the County and how it is affected by policy decisions made by the Board of Supervisors.

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO FURTHER PARTICIPATE IN THE REDISTRICTING - PROCESS?

1. Provide your comments on your community of interest by completing this worksheet and return it by email to the County Clerk at redistricting@yolocounty.org or drop off a hard copy to the County of Yolo, 625 Court Street, Woodland, CA 95695-1268 or attend a public hearing and read your comments to the board.
2. Attend one of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors public meetings, times and locations to be publicized on the website.
