Redistricting Commissioners,

Thank you for your service.

My name is [REDACTED], I'm a [REDACTED] but most importantly a Yolo County resident who is requesting that you recommend equitable and inclusive maps that will not dilute the representation of Woodland residents in the 5th District; in particular the Latino community. Please keep in mind maps #1 and #2 will reduce the Latino population in District 5 by 4-6%. This will likely be challenged by voting rights organizations if adopted.

Woodland's population has increased during the last 10 years by over 5,000 residents therefore, it would make sense that modifications be made to the 5th District boundaries to include more Woodland residents, not less.

Please recommend maps that are slightly modified in all districts and would be supported by law - Map #4 and Concilio map would accomplish both.
