
PROJECT PROPOSAL


- Proposed project site 319 acres of 442-acre Shifler property
- Proposed mining area 264 acres (other mining-related activity on 55 acres)
- Mining of 35.4 mil tons total (30.0 mil tons sold) over 30 years
- Maximum mining of 2.6 mil tons annually (2.2 mil tons sold) with 20% Exceedance
- Transfer of tonnage allocation from Esparto and Schwarzgruber permits
- Mining depths of 40 to 110 feet
- Authorize mining within Streamway Influence Zone
- Processing to occur at Teichert Woodland Plant
- No change in approved haul route or hours of operation
- Reclamation to agriculture, lake, and habitat














