Yolo County remains in the orange tier, but may move to the yellow tier on May 5th. While less than 50% of residents have been vaccinated, the County continues to offer free vaccinations.

Road 100B

During the April 6th BOS meeting, the Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the closure of County Road 100B for the use of Clark Pacific. The closure was approved and most importantly a positive solution was reached. Several months prior to the April 6th BOS meeting, Supervisor Barajas met with impacted residents and Clark Pacific to address concerns and impacts. These fruitful discussions resulted in a settlement that would appease all parties. In lieu of Rd. 100B being closed, Clark Pacific will construct a new paved private road for residents and agricultural vehicles to use. We like to thank the community and Clark Pacific for working together on this issue.

Flooding

On April 23rd, Supervisor Barajas and County staff met with West Plainfield residents and staff to discuss a study that was conducted providing recommendations for a potential long term flood plan. With discussions and suggestions at hand, county staff will create a conceptual proposal for residents regarding next steps. Next meeting is scheduled for May 28th at 10:30am.



Cannabis Land Use Ordinance (CLUO)

During the BOS meeting on 04/20, the Board of Supervisors received an update from County staff which included a proposal from the Yocha Dehe Wintun Board of Directors. Questions and comments were taken at the meeting however no action was taken. During the upcoming May 9th BOS meeting, the Board of Supervisors will provide direction to staff on 8 key areas of the CLUO, including minimum buffers and over-concentration thresholds.
