Sustainability Plan & Yolo County Climate Action Commission

During the May 4th BOS meeting, Yolo County Supervisors received a presentation to approve the 2021 Sustainability Plan which included updating the county's climate action plan and increasing food sovereignty and security. Along with the Sustainability Plan, Supervisors received a presentation to approve the Yolo County Climate Action Commission, intended as a working body to initiate an equitable climate mobilization, which is mentioned in the Sustainability Plan. The Board took action and approved both items.
