
SUPERVISOR UPDATES



Flooding

On June 22nd, Supervisor Barajas met with residents from West Plainfield to discuss issues regarding flood protection. While a regional long term flood protection plan is needed, Supervisor Barajas learned about the urgency of creating an immediate local mitigation plan. Supervisor Barajas will convene a meeting with residents and County staff to begin this process ahead of Winter 2021.

On June 23rd, Supervisor Barajas convened a virtual meeting with various Rotary club members in Yolo County, Knights Landing community leaders, Knights Landing Community Service District, and County staff to discuss several projects that would enhance the community of Knights Landing. Some of the projects include a ball wall, fire station repairs, and arsenic remediation for the 3rd St well. A meaningful dialogue was held among all stakeholders. We are very thankful that members of the Rotary clubs will be exploring the possibility of providing a ball wall at Sci-Tech Elementary School. A follow up meeting will be held next month!



On June 29th the Board of Supervisors will be presented with an update from staff regarding the American Rescue plan funds and a proposed use of those funds. Furthermore, Yolo County staff will also be holding multiple community workshops in the month of July to provide residents an opportunity to provide feedback on the proposed needs.
