Groundbreaking for County Road 40 Bridge & SR128/I-505 interchange ramp redesign



Supervisor Barajas also attended the groundbreaking of a federal funding project for the City of Winters and Caltrans to modify the SR128/I-505 interchange ramps in Winters to provide safer crossings for pedestrians and bicyclists.
