Yolo County Offers Information Session on Available Pre-Apprenticeship Training Program

(Woodland, CA) –Yolo County jobseekers now have the opportunity to join a Virtual Information Sessions on Tuesday, February 1, and Wednesday, February 2, at 11 am and 5 pm to learn about the upcoming Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) training cohort. The cohort, which begins March 7, is a partnership between the Yolo County Workforce Innovation Board (WIB), Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), Sacramento-Sierra's Building and Construction Trades Council, People Working Together, Highlands Community Charter School, and the California Workforce Development Board.

The MC3 training is part of the California Workforce Development Board's High Road Construction Careers with funding through SB1; a statewide initiative that puts dollars to work to advance careers in the building and construction trades as a reliable pathway to middle class for disadvantaged Californians via multi-craft pre-apprenticeship training. MC3 allows learners to pick up the tools and techniques of skilled trades, from plumbing to electrical work to sheet metal and iron work, under the guidance of master craftworkers. The general orientation course includes construction industry structure and the construction process; orientation to apprenticeship; tools of the various trades and the safe handling of both hand and power tools; and industry standards of work responsibility and craft excellence.
