Hold a Proposition 218 public hearing, tabulate ballots and adopt a resolution declaring the results of the ballot proceeding, and, if no majority protest exists, adopt a resolution ordering the levy of increases in the assessments for street lighting services of \$35 per parcel for FY 2022-23, subject to a maximum 5% inflationary adjustment in future years, for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District. (No general fund impact) (Echiburu/Villa)

Recommended Action

- A. Hold a Proposition 218 public hearing for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District to levy an increase in the annual assessment rate of \$13 per parcel for a total of \$35 per parcel per year for FY 2022-23 with establishment of an annual CPI adjustment up to 5% per year, direct staff to tabulate protests;
- B. Direct the Clerk to tabulate the ballots received prior to the close of the public hearing and adopt a resolution declaring the results of the protest ballot proceedings; and
- C. If no majority protest exists, adopt a resolution approving the Engineer's Report, confirming the diagram and assessment, and ordering the levy of the increased assessment for street lighting services for FY 2022-23 for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District.

Reason for Recommended Action/Background

The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District levies an annual street lighting assessment to provide street lighting services in Clarksburg pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets & Highways Code sections 22500 et seq.). A diagram of the properties subject to the assessment is included in the attached Engineer's Report (Attachment C).

The current Clarksburg street lighting annual assessment of \$22 per parcel was set in 1994 and has not been increased since. The 1994 rates are no longer sufficient to support the program and maintain service levels. The financial summary through fiscal year 2021-22 (Attachment B) shows that expenditures and costs to provide the street lighting services are in excess of revenues. The attached Engineer's Report for fiscal year 2022-23 provides updated information on anticipated expenses and shows that an increase of \$13 per parcel to the annual assessment is necessary to

meet the estimated costs to operate and maintain the street lights within the District (Attachment C). As such, the County will need to increase the total annual assessment to \$35 per parcel for fiscal year 2022-23, reduce the street lighting services, or consider dissolving the District due to insufficient funds to maintain the service at its present level. To meet ongoing operating and maintenance expenses, the Engineer's Report recommends the implementation of an annual inflationary adjustment of up to 5% per year. An informational letter was sent to all property owners notifying them of this recommended action and next steps (Attachment A).

To increase the annual assessment and establish the inflationary adjustment, the County must comply with Proposition 218's notice, protest, and hearing requirements set forth in article XIII D. section 4, of the California Constitution and Government Code section 53753. A notice and ballot must be mailed to property owners of record at least 45 days prior to the public hearing. On September 28, 2021, the Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution (Attachment D) initiating the Proposition 218 proceedings by preliminarily approving the Engineer's Report and setting the public hearing for November 23, 2021. A Notice and ballot information guide (Attachment E) was mailed with ballots (Attachment F) to each property owner of record within the District on October 1, 2021, more than 45 days before the public hearing, inviting property owners to attend the public hearing to voice their opinion about the proposed assessment. The Notice outlined the new assessment and provided the process and timeline for property owners to submit ballots to support or oppose the new assessment, along with a stamped return envelope for the ballots. Further outreach to the community included participation in the Clarksburg General Plan Advisory Committee Meeting and two community informational meetings held via Zoom. After the close of the public input portion of the public hearing, the Board will be asked to direct the Clerk to tabulate the ballots. The results of the tabulation are expected to be announced during the Board of Supervisors meeting. The proposed increase of \$13 per parcel to the annual assessment may not be imposed if the ballots submitted in opposition to the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in favor of the assessment.

If the Proposition 218 proceedings are successful (i.e. less than a majority of returned ballots protest the assessment) the increased annual assessment of \$35 per parcel will be collected on the property tax bill beginning in the 2022-2023 tax year. The annual assessment will continue in future years until terminated by the Board. After FY 2022-23, the assessment may be increased for inflation by an amount equal to the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics or five percent (5%), whichever is lower. Such an annual increase must be reviewed and approved each year at a public hearing held by the Board of Supervisors. Because costs are anticipated to increase, the inflationary adjustment will help keep the assessment revenues in line with the cost of operating and maintaining the District's streetlights in future years.

Dear Clarksburg Property Owners,

August 17, 2021

This letter is to inform you that your property is within the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District (LAD), also known as a County Service Area. The basic premise of a County Service Area is for communities to fund a service by charging a direct assessment on the property. The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District was formed in 1982 by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors, who govern the district to provide streetlighting to the community.

Yolo County plans to take steps to ensure adequate funding for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District. There are 24 streetlights in operation, and not enough funds to keep all of the lights in operation.

Included with this letter is a 5-year financial summary of revenues and expenses in relation to the Clarksburg street lights, showing expenditures are in excess of revenues. The present lighting assessment of \$22 per parcel has been in effect since 1994 and has not increased since. Absent an increase in the assessment, the County will either need to reduce or no longer provide these services. The amount of revenue necessary to continue street lighting services in the LAD is recommended by an engineering study that indicates the need for an annual per parcel assessment for street lighting service of \$35 per year, compared to the present assessment of \$22 per year.

The Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to initiate the Proposition 218 process and to set a future public hearing to consider an increase in the assessment on Tuesday, August 31, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. As part of the Prop. 218 process, property owners in the LAD will be provided additional information about the increase and given an opportunity to support or oppose a revised street lighting assessment.

Shortly after the Board initiates the Prop. 218 process, a mailing will go to all property owners outlining the proposed assessment charge and providing the process and timeline for property owners to submit ballots to support or oppose the new charges. The mailings will include a notice of the public hearing on the matter which we anticipate being held sometime in October. If there is no majority protest and the Prop. 218 proceedings for the increased assessment are successful (i.e. the votes in opposition of the new charge do not exceed those in favor), the lighting services will continue. If a majority protest exists and the assessment cannot be implemented, those services will no longer be provided, starting in fiscal year 2022-23, as the County cannot provide services for which the LAD does not have the means to fund.

The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District ("District") is responsible for providing street light services for the community of Clarksburg. The District was formed on August 10,1982 by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets & Hwy Code §§ 22500) with the adoption of Resolution No. 82-108. The street lights are operated and maintained by the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and the street light service provided within the District for the benefit of the District's property owners is currently funded from an annual assessment of \$22 per parcel, approved on June 21, 1994. The annual assessment has not increased since 1994. The assessment proceeds are exclusively used for providing street light services within the District, including servicing and maintenance, plus incidental expenses.

In accordance with the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, this report has been prepared to determine the annual assessments required for the costs of operating and maintaining the District's street lights. There are 174 parcels within the District. Please see the attached Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District Map identifying the 174 District parcels within the District boundary. An Assessment Roll of the 174 parcels is also attached. The street lights constructed and maintained with the assessment proceeds are all located within the District boundaries and provide special benefits to the assessed properties with illumination to streets and sidewalks enabling improved access and safety to the District's residents.

Recommendations

As the projected revenue requirements require a \$13 per parcel increase in the current annual assessment to \$35 per parcel, the District will need to follow the Proposition 218 procedures pursuant to Article XIIID, Section 4 of the California Constitution and Government Code section 53753 to implement the proposed increase in the District's assessment.

Because costs are anticipated to increase annually and the District has very limited reserves, it is recommended that the proposed annual maximum tax rate of \$35 per parcel also include approval for an annual increase in future years not to exceed the Consumer



RESOLUTION NO. 21-123

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF YOLO DECLARING INTENTION TO ORDER LEVY AND COLLECTION OF FY 2022-23 ASSESSMENT, GRANTING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF ENGINEER'S REPORT, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE CLARKSBURG LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California (the "Board") is authorized, pursuant to the authority provided by the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500 thereof) ("the Act") to levy and collect assessments for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District ("Assessment District"); and

WHEREAS, Articles XIIIC and XIIID of the California Constitution and implementing statutes impose certain procedural and substantive requirements relating to assessments (as defined); and

WHEREAS, as an annual assessment of \$22 per parcel was authorized in June 1994 and has not been increased since that time, but costs of operating and maintaining the streetlights within the Assessment District have increased and an Engineer's Report has been prepared by Todd Riddiough, a licensed engineer, concluding a \$13 per parcel increase in the annual assessment is necessary to meet the total anticipated costs for FY 2022-23 with an annual inflationary adjustment not to exceed 5% per year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo that:

- 1. It is the intention of the Board to levy and collect assessments within the Assessment District for fiscal year 2022-23 pursuant to the Act and Article XIIID of the California Constitution.
- 2. An engineer's report has been prepared pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Article XIIID of the California Constitution (the "Report"). The Report has been made, filed with the Clerk of the Board and duly considered by the Board and is hereby deemed sufficient and preliminarily approved. The Report shall stand as the engineer's report for all subsequent proceedings under and pursuant to this resolution.
- 3. Within the Assessment District, the existing and proposed improvements to be undertaken by the Assessment District are generally described as the installation or construction of public lighting facilities, the installation and construction of any facilities which are pertinent to the foregoing, or which are necessary or convenient for the maintenance or serving thereof, or both, of the foregoing. "Installation" means the construction of improvements, including but not limited to, streetlights and land preparation, such as grading, leveling, cutting and filling. "Maintenance" means the furnishing of services and materials for the ordinary and usual maintenance of said street light improvements, including repair, removal, or replacement of all or part of any improvement; and the cleaning, sandblasting, and painting of light poles and other

improvements to remove graffiti. "Servicing" means the furnishing of electric current, or energy, or other illuminating agent for any public lighting facilities or for the lighting or operation of any other improvements, or the maintenance of any other improvements.

- 4. Reference is hereby made to the Report for a description of the improvements, the boundaries of the Assessment District and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the Assessment District.
- 5. The Assessment District consists of the lots and parcels shown on the boundary map of the Assessment District on file with the Clerk of the Board, and reference is hereby made to such map for further particulars.
- 6. The Assessment may be continued annually and may be adjusted by up to the maximum annual inflationary adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI-W and CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, or five percent (5%), whichever is lower, without any additional assessment ballot proceeding.
- 7. It is the intention of this Board to levy and collect assessments within the Assessment District. The estimated fiscal year 2022-23 cost of providing the maintenance, operations, and servicing of the streetlights within the Assessment District is \$6,127.00. This cost results in a proposed annual assessment rate as follows: THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$35.00) per parcel.
- 8. It is the further intention of the Board to have the assessment collected on the tax toll in the same manner, by the same persons, and at the same time as, together with and not separately from, its general taxes.
- 9. The Board of Supervisors orders that a public hearing shall be held before this board, located at 625 Court Street, Woodland, California on **Tuesday, November 23, 2021** at the hour of **9:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, to consider the levy of the continued assessments and ballots for the increased fiscal year 2022-23.
- 10. The Clerk of the Board shall cause a notice of the hearing to be given by publishing a notice, at least ten days prior to the date of the public hearing, in a newspaper circulated in the County.
- 11. Pursuant to Article XIIID, section 4 and Government Code section 53753, notice shall further be provided by giving notice of the proposed increase in the maximum assessment rate and inflationary adjustment as follows:
 - a. The record owner(s) of each parcel to be assessed shall be determined from the last equalized secured property tax assessment roll. If the property tax roll indicates more than one owner, each owner shall receive notice, though each parcel will only get one vote.
 - b. The notice and ballot shall be mailed to record owner(s) at least forty-five (45) days prior to the November 23, 2021 public hearing. The ballot shall comply with Government Code section 53753.

- c. Failure of any person to receive notice shall not invalidate the proceedings.
- d. The cost of preparing and providing notice shall be included as a cost of the assessment.
- e. All ballots must be returned either by mail or hand delivery prior to the close of the public hearing and will be tabulated in accordance with the procedures set forth in the notice ballot notice and information guide mailed to record owner(s) and Government Code section 53753.
- f. Assessment ballots shall remain sealed until the tabulation of ballots commences after the close of the public hearing, provided that an assessment ballot may be submitted, or changed, or withdrawn by the person who submitted the ballot prior to the conclusion of the public testimony on the proposed assessment at the public hearing.
- g. A majority protest exists if the assessment ballots submitted, and not withdrawn, in opposition to the proposed assessment exceed the assessment ballots submitted, and not withdrawn, in its favor, weighting those assessment ballots by the amount of the proposed assessment to be imposed upon the identified parcel for which each assessment ballot was submitted. If there is a majority protest against the proposed increase in the existing assessment, the increase shall not be imposed.



The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District ("District") was formed pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets & Hwy Code §§ 22500). The Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 and article XIII D, section 4 of the California Constitution require the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District to notify property owners of a new or increased assessment for street lighting services. This letter serves as notice of the following:

• The District is considering increased assessments for street lighting services of \$13 per year per parcel for properties within the District. If approved, the new charges will annually appear on your property tax bill, beginning with the fiscal year 2022-23 property tax bill.

- A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, November 23, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Yolo County Board of Supervisors Chambers (or telephonically if necessary due to the COVID-19 pandemic) to receive public comment and protests on the proposed street lighting assessments.

REASON FOR THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT INCREASE & BASIS UPON WHICH THE AMOUNT OF THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT WAS CALCULATED

The District is responsible for providing street lighting services for the community of Clarksburg in accordance with its formation on August 10, 1982 by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors pursuant to the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (Streets & Hwy Code §§ 22500 et seq.). The streetlights are operated and maintained by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and the service is funded from an annual assessment of \$22 per parcel that has not increased since 1994. As a result, the revenues have not kept pace with increasing expenses. The current assessment does not generate enough revenue to pay for the necessary operations and maintenance required to provide street lighting services within the District.

The proposed assessment for FY 2022-23 for each property within the District was determined based upon an Engineer's Report prepared by a registered professional engineer certified by the State of California. The Engineer's Report analyzed the estimated costs for operation and maintenance of the streetlights within the District as well as the special benefits provided by the streetlights, including improved access and safety to properties within the District. Streetlight poles and related electrical hardware must be maintained regularly to prevent light outages, pay for electricity, and maintain or replace the poles as needed.

Street Lighting Service Costs

As explained in the Engineer's Report, the estimated cost of the providing the streetlight service within the District, including charges for PG&E street lighting service (electricity), the need for a 10% rate reserve against increases in PG&E rates, and the cost to administer street lighting services at current levels, is as follows:

The assessment per parcel for the 174 parcels within the District was calculated based upon this estimated cost analysis in the Engineer's Report. The proposed annual assessment for your property to continue services at current levels is \$35.00 per year, which is an increase of \$13.00 annually from the current \$22.00 annual assessment. The proposed \$35 annual assessment will be assessed annually on your property tax bill.

The annual assessment will continue in future years until terminated by the Board. After 2022-23, however, the assessment may be increased for inflation by an amount equal to the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics or five percent (5%), whichever is lower. The rate shall be rounded to the nearest dollar. Such an annual increase must be reviewed and approved each year at a public hearing held by the Board of Supervisors. Because costs are anticipated to increase, the inflationary adjustment will help keep the assessment revenues in line with the cost of operating and maintaining the District's streetlights in future years.

Notice of Public Hearing - How do I participate in this assessment proceeding?

The Yolo County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing to consider the proposed increased assessment on Tuesday, November 23, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, located in the County Administration Building at 625 Court Street, Room 206 in Woodland. Please check the County's website at www.yolocounty.org for more information about how to participate in the meeting in case of changes to meetings due to the COVID-19 pandemic or call (530) 666-8725 with questions.

You are invited, but not required, to attend the public hearing and to present oral or written testimony to the Board of Supervisors. At the public hearing, the Board will consider all objections or protests, if any, to the proposed assessment. The public hearing may be continued from time to time, if necessary.

Ballot Instructions – How do the assessment proceedings work?

The proposed increase to the lighting assessment is subject to a majority protest proceeding. If, upon the conclusion of the hearing, ballots submitted in opposition to the increased assessment exceed the ballots submitted in favor of the assessment (i.e. a majority protest), the increased assessment will not be imposed. *See* California Constitution, article XIII D, § 4. In the event of a majority protest, the County may consider options of reducing hours the streetlights are operational or reducing the amount of active streetlights.

A ballot is included with this notice. Ballots are weighted by the proposed amount of the assessment and will be tabulated accordingly. Since each parcel within the District is subject to a proposed annual assessment of \$35.00, each valid ballot submitted will be of equal weight and will count as one vote. Any property owner may submit a written ballot, but only one ballot per parcel will be counted, even if there are co-owners.

To complete the enclosed official ballot, mark the oval next to either "Yes" or "No," sign the ballot, place it in the postage paid envelope provided, and mail to: Clerk of the Yolo County Board of Supervisors, 625 Court Street, Room 204, Woodland, CA 95695. You may also hand-deliver your ballot to the Clerk of the Board's Office at 625 Court Street, Room 204, Woodland, CA 95695, which is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Ballots cannot be sent electronically. The ballot must be received by the conclusion of the public input portion of the November 23, 2021 public hearing in order to be counted.

Only official ballots that are signed and marked with the owner's support or opposition and are received before the end of the public comment portion of the public hearing to be held by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 23, 2021 will be counted. Post marks do not count.

Ballots will not be tabulated before the close of the public comment portion of the public hearing, but ballots will be public records during and after tabulation. A ballot may be submitted, changed or withdrawn by the person who submitted it before the conclusion of the public input portion of the public hearing. It is anticipated that the results of the tabulation will be announced prior to the conclusion of the Board of Supervisors meeting on November 23, 2021.

This notice has been addressed to the parcel owner shown on the last equalized secured property tax assessment roll. In the event a person not shown on the last equalized secured property tax assessment roll assumes (or otherwise has) ownership of a parcel, that person may submit a written ballot with respect to that parcel. Such ballot should include all information otherwise required of a written ballot and must also include either proof of such ownership or a statement, submitted under penalty of perjury by the person submitting the written ballot, that the person signing the ballot is the owner of the parcel or is legally entitled to file the ballot for the owner of the parcel.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YOLO COUNTY APPROVING ENGINEER'S REPORT, CONFIRMING DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT, AND ORDERING LEVY OF THE CLARKSBURG LIGHTING DISTRICT ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, State of California (the "Board") is authorized, pursuant to the authority provided by the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500 thereof) to levy and collect assessments for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District ("Assessment District"); and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2021, the Board preliminarily approved an Engineer's Report which includes: (1) a description of the streetlight operations and improvements to be funded with assessment proceeds; (2) an estimate of the annual cost of services described in the Engineer's Report; (3) a diagram and boundary map for the Assessment District; and (4) a specification of the amount to be assessed upon the parcels within the Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, the form of written mailed public notice of the public meeting contained the following information: (1) the total amount of assessments to be levied within the district for fiscal year 2022-2023, as well as the inflationary adjustment applicable to future assessments; (2) the assessment chargeable to each owner's parcel; (3) the duration of the proposed assessment; (4) the reason for the assessment; (5) the basis upon which the amount of the proposed assessment was calculated; (6) the date, time and place of the public hearing as specified in this resolution; and (7) a summary of the voting procedures and the effect of a majority protest.

WHEREAS, the form of the written mailed public notice mailed to the property owners of record also included a ballot by which each property owner could express their support or opposition to the proposed assessment increase; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of California Constitution Article XIII-D, section 4, and Government Code section 53753, an opportunity for protest has been afforded, and the

assessment ballots mailed to record owners of assessable real property within the established boundaries of the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District have been received and tabulated, with assessment ballots weighted according to the proportional financial obligation of each affected parcel (one vote per parcel for this proceeding); and

WHEREAS, the Board has examined and reviewed the Engineer's Report, considered all public testimony and written protests presented, and evaluated the results of the property owner protest ballot proceedings for the proposed assessments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Final Engineer's Report for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District, together with the diagram and boundary map of the Assessment contained therein, and the proposed assessment roll for the fiscal year 2022-2023, are hereby confirmed and approved; and
- 2. Based on the oral and documentary evidence, including the Engineer's Report, offered and received at the public hearing, the Board expressively finds and determines that (a) each of the several assessed lots and parcels of land within the Assessment District will be specially benefited in at least the amount of the Assessment apportioned against such lots and parcels of land, respectively; and (b) that there is substantial evidence to support, and the weight of the evidence preponderated in favor of, said finding and determination as to special benefit to property with the Assessment to be financed with assessment proceeds; and
- 3. As determined by the ballot tabulation certified by the Deputy Clerk, since a majority protest, as defined by Article XIII D of the California Constitution, does not exist, this Board thereby acquired jurisdiction to order the levy of the increased assessments.
- 4. The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District's assessments, including the approved annual increase to the existing assessment of \$13.00 per parcel, consistent with the Engineer's Report are hereby levied, pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 Part 2 of Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code (commencing with Section 22500 thereof) and Article XIII-D of the California Constitution; and
- 5. The Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District assessments for fiscal year 2022-2023 shall be levied on the tax roll at the rate of **THIRTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$35.00) per parcel**, as specified in the Engineer's Report for fiscal year 2022-2023, with estimated total annual assessment revenues as set forth in the Engineer's Report; and
- 6. The Assessment may be continued annually and may be adjusted by up to the maximum annual inflationary adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI-W and CPIU) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, or five percent (5%), whichever is lower, without any additional assessment ballot proceeding.
