On behalf of CEMEX Construction Materials Pacific, LLC. (“CEMEX”), please accept this Application Addendum No. 3 (“Addendum 3”) for the Cache Creek Mining Permit and Reclamation Plan Amendment Project (“Project”). The sole purpose of this Addendum 3 is to formally withdraw CEMEX’s request to increase the annual production limit for the mine from 1,000,000 tons sold per year to 1,500,000 tons sold per year. As part of the Project, CEMEX now proposes no change to the annual permitted volume of mined or sold tons. All other aspects of the Project application submitted February 28, 2018 and as modified by Addendum 1 on April 1, 2020 and Addendum 2 on December 21, 2020, remain the same.
