

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-033, SERIES 2022**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CHARGE CONNECTION FEES ASSOCIATED WITH ONE-INCH WATER METERS FOR WATER SERVICE TO NORTH DAVIS MEADOWS COUNTY SERVICE AREA**

WHEREAS, the City of Davis, California ("City") is a municipal corporation, duly organized under the constitution and laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the North Davis Meadows county service area has significant water quality concerns with the existing potable water supply, and has been advised not to use the existing potable water system for drinking since 2009; and

WHEREAS, Yolo County and the City have entered into an agreement to consolidate the North Davis Meadows county service area water system with the City's water system; and

WHEREAS, the design for the consolidation originally included one-inch water meters and associated connection fees; and

WHEREAS, the County Proposition 218 approved fees for the consolidation included the one-inch water meter connection fees; and

WHEREAS, the project and design were reviewed and reevaluated in 2021, and it was determined that additional infrastructure is required, which necessitates one-and-a-half-inch water meters due to pressure reductions with the same anticipated water demand; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered by the City's Municipal Code Section 39.03.200 (Special Charges) to make charges for water different from rates established by Code in the event that special circumstances make the charges reasonable and fair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Davis does hereby authorize the City Manager to direct staff to charge connection fees associated with one-inch water meters for water service for the North Davis Meadows service area.
