• Yolo County Board of Supervisor's received a correspondence from the Yolo Food Bank, asking to update their staff liaison and have asked that Yolo County re-entertain the option of extending the funding back to them.

b. Member Updates

Yolo County - Ramin Yazdani

- Yolo County will be celebrating national Public Works Week, Wednesday, May 18th, 2022 from 2:00 pm 4:00 pm here at the Yolo County Central Landfill.
- Free compost has been extended through May.
- Module 6H construction has begun. In the next couple of weeks, we should start laying liner. We're expecting this to be completed by the end of summer.
- A second bond in the amount of \$10 million is for the construction of module 6H and for the construction of module G (pond). The bidding process is underway.
- Thank you, Dotty Pritchard for your help coordinating our grand opening for the anaerobic composter and in vessel digester scheduled for July 9th at 9:00 am.
- Composting facility updates currently finishing off the equipment installation inside the covered area and paving. The last biggest hurdle is PGE. We are looking into solar from ForeFront Power, we are currently designing electricity for the entire site plus the composting facility.

- The tire amnesty event was very success full. We had a total of 1693 tires. Most of these tires were the large semi-truck tires. For this event we worked with the Fam Bureau and the ag department to get a mailing of all our growers and we sent them coupons.
- Yolo County electronic waste contract will be going out to bid next month, it will expire on June 30th.
