

Reclamation District 108 - 150th Anniversary



On Wednesday, June 29th, Supervisor Barajas presented Reclamation District 108 with a resolution commemorating the 150th anniversary of its formation.

On October 4, 1870, landowners submitted a petition to the Colusa and Yolo County Boards of Supervisors authorizing the formation of a new Reclamation District and assigned it the number 108. The Reclamation District Law of 1868 established the District to build levees and "reclaim" land subject to periodic overflow from neighboring rivers and water bodies.

The Reclamation District No. 108 is located along the western edge of the Sacramento River and supplies water to nearly 48,000 acres of farmland in southern Colusa County and northern Yolo County.

Yolo County Farmworker Program




At the June 28 BOS meeting, a specific agricultural worker workplan and a recommended budget of \$246,000 was presented to the Board of Supervisors.

The historic formation of the Farmworker Ad Hoc highlighted the need for a full-time ag coordinator position (which the County is currently accepting applications for), a .5 FTE staff for Health Care Services, along with other dedicated staff who will serve Farm workers in the capacity of: housing, food security, medical, education, immigration, legal support, employment assistance and legal support.

We are committed to improving the lives of farmworkers in Yolo County, and as a result, we hope that other agricultural counties will follow in Yolo County's footsteps.

SwimAmerica provided the lessons, which were made possible by a collaboration between Barajas and Saylor, Davis Sunrise Rotary, Yolo County Transportation District, and community resident Maria Martinez. Swimming lessons were previously put on hold for two years due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We are incredibly excited to provide free swim lessons for the youth of Knights Landing," Barajas said. "Not only do swim lessons help save lives, but they provide physical and social development for our youth." This is an activity we hope to continue every summer.
