Engineer's Report

- Engineering study required
 - Budget and assessment rate based on service level needs
 - Amount of special benefit each property receives must be defined
 - Assessment amounts for different property types based on property use type, parcel size, number of dwelling units
 - Distance from fire station and fire hazard zones
- Must be prepared by a qualified licensed Civil Engineer

- If the property is owned by another legal entity, the assessment ballot may be signed by any person authorized by law to make contracts for the entity.
- If the property is owned by a public agency, the assessment ballot may be signed by any person authorized by law to make contracts for the agency or by resolution of the agency's Governing Board.




