A

Aerosol cans empty - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - see DTSC guidelines at Empty Aerosols ([PDF](#))

Aerosol cans NOT EMPTY - (Current acceptance of full aerosol cans is on **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**)

Ag Irrigation Drip Tape - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **SOLID WASTE FEE APPLY**

Agricultural Pesticide containers (approved plastic & metal containers will be recycled) HDPE plastic crop protection and other EPA registered pesticide product containers from agricultural and professional end users are applicable for this program. Drums must be cut in half for acceptance and containers larger than 55 gallons require written approval for acceptance. Call the landfill at **(530) 666-8852** for more information.

All containers must first be triple rinsed then certified/inspected by the Ag Department prior to drop-off. Contact the [Yolo County Ag Dept](#) **(530) 666-8140** to make an appointment for inspection and certification.

(Current acceptance of ag pesticide containers is on **Fridays only from 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**) Please remove any label booklets plastic sleeves, paper, metal, caps, lids, bungs, and the majority, of foil from spout.

Pesticide container for this program, are not from home, garden, antimicrobial products, veterinary products, or other noncommercial uses. No pesticide or other crop protection containers that were never filled, filled, and never distributed or were subject of a recall.

(Agricultural) fumi-Cel pesticide packs - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - Bags/packs must be wetted, dewatered, and inspected. Packs must be accompanied by a Yolo County Ag Dept inspection form to be considered safe for disposal. Standard Disposal fees apply. Appointments for inspection can be made by contacting the [Yolo County Ag Dept](#) **(530) 666-8140**

Aluminum cans - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - #1, #2 #5 and #7 okay.

Air conditioner - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **APPLIANCE FEE APPLIES** - includes standalone, window and portable units.

Antifreeze - **ACCEPTED** **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Asbestos - friable or non-friable - **ACCEPTED** **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - **No longer than 3 ft in length, must be wetted, double bagged, securely sealed, and labeled to be accepted** at the HHW events or customers my contact Class II Landfills for disposal options.

Asbestos - from businesses (friable or non-friable) - Businesses who are small quantity generators of hazardous waste may contact the County at **(530) 666-8856** for an appointment to pay for proper

disposal through our Household Hazardous Waste facility. **No longer than 3 ft in length, must be wetted, double bagged, securely sealed, and labeled to be accepted.**

Asphalt - road asphalt is **ACCEPTED** at no cost - (concrete gravel, sand, moderate wire, rebar ok) Minimal soil with asphalt is ok. It is OK for rebar to be incased in the asphalt, but it is not OK for asphalt to be incased in rebar.

Bamboo - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

Batteries - automotive, motorcycle - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - [Household batteries](#) - non-rechargeable, alkaline, button batteries from watches, etc. - rechargeable nickel cadmium Ni-Cd, Nickel Metal Hydride Ni-MH, Lithium ion (Li-ion) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - (Yolo County Residents only)

Brake Fluid - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Burn Waste - **Call the landfill prior to hauling for approval information** - Burn waste is things like fire damage buildings and structures or large burn pile debris. Some burn waste will require testing prior to approval. Charcoal from a BBQ is not considered burn waste.

C

C & D - See the Construction & Demolition Debris brochure ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#) - Currently mixed C&D is recycled. Source separated wood, metal and concrete can also be accepted for recycling.

Cactus - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

Cannabis - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#) - Cannabis Disposal Procedures ([PDF](#))

Cardboard - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - *accepted*: corrugated cardboard, shipping boxes - *not accepted*: waxed cardboard, cereal cartons, egg cartons paper grocery bags and packing materials.

Carpet - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#) - Carpet Program ([PDF](#))

Cartons - empty: milk, juice, soy, etc. - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING**

Cell Phones - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#) - Free for Yolo County Resident - Fees apply for businesses.

Centerfuges - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#) - units contains Freon and therefore should be recycled and charged appropriate fees as an appliance.

Chemicals - toxics - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Christmas trees - **ACCEPTED** - must have no ornaments, flocking, tinsel, garland, lights, and the stand must be removed in order, to be recycled otherwise it will be land filled as garbage.

Cooking oil and grease - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY** - trash fee applies if brought in solidified in absorbent or kitty litter - **NO FEE** If brought in during **Household Hazardous Waste Fridays and Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Concrete - Free of charge if clean of debris, moderate wire, rebar must not be in cased in concrete, rebar must be between 1/4" and 1/2"

Creosote treated wood - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY** - Limited acceptability small lengths 5' or less - Large quantities contact Recology Hay Road Landfill (800) 208-2370

Cylinders - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - fire extinguishers and propane tanks up to 23.6 gallons (20#-100#) - for other cylinders not accepted please contact Praxair at (916) 452-1234

Cylinders - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES MAY APPLY**- ONLY small helium balloon party tanks, air compressors, water heater expansion tanks or water tanks.

D

Dead Animals - **NOT ACCEPTED** - unacceptable - livestock, wild game, or large household pet, either whole or in pieces, which would have constituted a whole animal - other options: Contact animal services, veterinarians, dead animal haulers or rendering plants for disposal information.

Dead Animals - and animal parts - **ACCEPTED** - small household pets, must be securely bagged in plastic (bird, fish, rodent, reptile, cat, small dog, etc.) Animal parts that do not constitute a whole animal, spoiled food, or by products from butchering activities. - other options: Contact animal services, veterinarians, dead animal haulers or rendering plants for disposal information.

Developer - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Dirt - Criteria for Soil/Waste Acceptance Yolo County Central Landfill ([YCCL](#))

Dishwashers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY**

Drums empty - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - must be open for inspection lids off or if there are only bung openings, they must be cut in half.

Dryers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY**

E

Electronic waste - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - computer monitors, laptops, televisions, and/or DVD players containing cathode ray tubes (CRT), liquid crystal display (LCD). plasma screens - These items are covered by the Electronic Waste Recycling Act.

Explosives - ammunition, bullets, airbags etc., - **NOT ACCEPTED** - other options - contact local law enforcement at (530) 666-8920 for details on proper disposal.

F

Fertilizer containers- empty - containers (approved plastic & metal containers will be recycled) Containers larger than 55 gallons require written approval for acceptance. Call the landfill at **(530) 666-8852** for more information. All containers must first be certified. Contact the Yolo County Ag Dept. **(530) 666-8140** to make an appointment for inspection and certification. (Current acceptance of ag plastics is on **Fridays only from 7:30 - 3:30 p.m.**) Please remove any label booklets plastic sleeves, paper, metal, caps, lids, bungs, and the majority, of foil from spout.

Containers must be certified triple rinsed (contact Yolo County Ag Dept.) dry, non-refillable. HDPE plastic crop protection and other EPA registered pesticide product containers from agricultural and professional end users.

They must not be from home, garden, antimicrobial products, veterinary products, or other noncommercial uses. No pesticide or other crop protection containers that were never filled, filled, and never distributed or were subject of a recall.

Fire Debris - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - Call the landfill prior to hauling for approval information - Criteria for Soil/Waste Acceptance Yolo County Central Landfill ([YCCL](#))

Fire extinguishers - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - fire extinguishers and propane tanks up to 23.6 gallons (20#-100#) - for other cylinders not accepted please contact Praxair at (916) 452-1234.

Flares, emergency road flares - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Fluorescent tubes & bulbs (residential) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY**- (Yolo residents only)

Fluorescent tubes & bulbs (commercial) - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - must call for an appointment (800) 207-8222.

Freezers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

Furnaces - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

Furniture (sofas, mattresses, large chairs) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

G

Gasoline - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Glass beverage containers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FREE RECYCLING** - glass containers must be rinsed, discard plastic lids & caps.

Gravel - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **NO CHARGE** - must be clean.

Green waste - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY** - leaves, grass, branches, brush, bamboo, tree rounds not to exceed 12" in length, straw / hay bedding and manure, bamboo, palm fronds, cactus - **Green waste RESTRICTIONS: [Sudden Oak Death](#); [Light Brown Apple Moth](#); [LBAM Quarantine Facts](#)** - Commercial haulers and landscaper's must sign a [Compliance Agreement](#) to haul and dispose of restricted green waste.

H

Hazardous waste - (residential [PDF](#)) - Accepted **Friday and Saturday** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - (business) must call for an appointment **(800) 207-8222**.

Helium 5-gallon tanks - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** **FEES APPLY** - ONLY small helium balloon party tanks, air compressors, water heater expansions tanks, or water tanks.

Herbicides, pesticides - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - (business) must call for an appointment **(800) 207-8222**.

Hospital Beds - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [Mattresses can be recycled](#); Metal frames can be recycled through metals; any electronics can be recycled in e-waste.

Hydraulic fluid (brake) - **ACCEPTED Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Hydraulic oil ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY**

I

Infectious Waste - **NOT ACCEPTED** - Contact [Yolo County Environmental Health](#) for proper disposal.

Ink & Toner Cartridges - **ACCEPTED** if empty - **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.** - **Businesses** must call for an appointment **(800) 207-8222**. Subject to Household Hazardous Waste disposal fees. **Residential - FREE RECYCLING** - (Yolo County residents only)

K

Kegs - **NOT ACCEPTED** - Must be recycled through distributor.

L

Lawn Mowers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - **FEES APPLY** Fuel powered units must be drained of all oil and gasoline. Electric powered units must have battery removed prior to recycling.

Light Ballasts - **ACCEPTED** - If bulbs are removed (ex. HID bulbs fluorescent bulbs. etc.) and Capacitor/Transformer is removed the light fixture itself is accepted as metals recycling. Capacitors and ballasts clearly marked "No-PCBs" can be accepted free of charge as E-Waste. - **NOT**

ACCEPTED - Ballasts and Capacitors (unlabeled or containing PCBs) accepted **Fridays** and **Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** events from 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Light Bulbs - ACCEPTED - (incandescent, halogen LED & non-mercury containing bulbs) Safe for disposal in regular trash container. (LED traffic lights require disposal) For mercury containing bulbs, See Fluorescent Tubes/Bulbs above.

Liquid Waste PDF - ACCEPTED - call the landfill prior to hauling for acceptance criteria - (530) - 666-8727.

M

Manure - ACCEPTED - for disposal (includes straw/hay bedding mixed with manure).

Mattress PDF - ACCEPTED - (Daily for free recycling) - Futon Mattresses now accepted ([PDF](#)).

Medical Waste - ACCEPTED - (sharps, including needles, lancets, test strips, etc). (Pharmaceuticals) **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. - (business) must call for an appointment (800) 207-8222. **Controlled substances: Bring to HHW events to get an authorized postage paid mailer for proper disposal. Treated Medical Waste** - call the landfill for approval information. **Untreated Medical Waste - NOT ACCEPTED** - Contact [Yolo County Environmental Health](#) for proper disposal.

Mercury - ACCEPTED - (thermometers, switches, medical dilators, medical weighted tubing, blood pressure meters, dental amalgam, pressure gauge, vacuum gauge, novelties including flashing athletic shoes, shoes, jewelry, singing greeting cards, etc.) **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Mercury Thermostat Collection Act PDF.

Metal Scrap - ACCEPTED - (Daily for Free recycling).

Microwaves - ACCEPTED EVERY DAY - FEES APPLY.

Mixed Recyclables - ACCEPTED - FREE RECYCLING - (Plastic, glass containers, aluminum cans, tin cans clean foil & trays, aseptic, juice box type containers) Must be rinsed, discard plastic lids & caps, no plastic bags of film wrap #1, #2, #5, and #7 okay. **Exclusions:** #6 - Styrofoam trays & carry out containers #4 - film plastics such as bags/plastic wrap #3 PVC pipe - DISPOSAL ONLY mirrors, window glass and light bulbs.

N

Neon bulbs/lights - ACCEPTED - Businesses pay a fee and must be preapproved

Newspaper - ACCEPTED - (Daily for free recycling)

O

Oil ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED** - (Daily for free recycling) - 15 gallon limit - Motor oil, transmission fluid, hydraulic fluid, kerosene, differential fluid, diesel fuel and diesel oil (5-gallon or less sized containers required to reduce spillage when pouring oil into tank) **NO CHLORINATED SOLVENTS/FLUIDS** - (ie brake cleaner power steering fluid). Brake fluids, Transformer fluids. **Oil filters** - **ACCEPTED** - (Daily for free recycling)

Ovens - **ACCEPTED** - [FEES APPLY](#)

P

Paint - **ACCEPTED** - latex and acrylic water based) - containers must be sealed with no leaks, must have original label and be easily identifiable as latex paint. **Unlabeled, unreadable, or corroded containers must be taken to *Household Hazardous Waste* on **Fridays and Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**** - Oil based paint, business/commercial customers must make an appointment before (800) 207-8222 - Oil based paint from residential customers **ACCEPTED** - paint containers must be sealed with no leaks, have original label, and be easily identifiable as oil-based paint. Unlabeled, unreadable, or corroded containers must be taken to ***Household Hazardous Waste* on **Fridays and Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**** Dried paint cans will be accepted, or you can dispose of them in your home garbage.

Pallets - **ACCEPTED** - [FEES APPLY](#)

Paper - **ACCEPTED** - Free recycling of junk mail, grocery bags, phone books, white paper, colored paper, magazines, envelopes, paper bags, and paper egg cartons.

PCB - **NOT ACCEPTED** - (Light ballasts **clearly marked "Non-PCB"** are accepted free of charge as part of the electronic waste recycling program.) PCB - containing materials (capacitors, ballasts, electrical transformers, transformer components) are accepted during the ***Household Hazardous Waste* on **Fridays and Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.****

PCP Treated Wood ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED** - pressure treated wood (Effective 3/15/21 accepted from Yolo County residents and businesses only) Limited acceptability, small lengths 5' or less, disassembled/separated. Large quantities and out of county - Check the following DTSC website for current list of disposal sites approved to accept PTW under SB 68 Variance Program: <https://dtsc.ca.gov/toxics-in-products/treated-wood-waste/>

Pesticide containers (plastic) - ([See agricultural plastics](#))

Pesticide containers (metal) - ([See agricultural plastics](#))

Pesticide containers (funicle packs) - ([See agricultural plastics](#))

Plastic beverage containers - ([see mixed recyclables](#))

Plastic carryout bags - **ACCEPTED** - for disposal only - Recycling drop-off located at supermarket and large retail stores.

Plastic lumber - **ACCEPTED** For disposal only.

Plastic, rigid plastics - **ACCEPTED** - free recycling (toys, buckets, bins, flowerpots, ice chest, lawn furnace etc.)

Poisons - **NOT ACCEPTED** must be taken to **Household Hazardous Waste** on **Fridays** and **Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Pools chemicals - **NOT ACCEPTED** must be taken to **Household Hazardous Waste** on **Fridays** and **Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Propane tanks up to 23.6 gallons (20#-100#) - **NOT ACCEPTED** must be taken to **Household Hazardous Waste** on **Fridays** and **Saturdays 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

PVC - (commercial pipe ONLY) free recycling may be available with prior approval, otherwise for disposal.

R

Radioactive - decommissioned materials - **NO** contact [Yolo County Environmental Health](#) for proper disposal.

Railroad ties - ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY FEES APPLY** - Limited acceptability, small lengths 5" or less, disassembled/separated.

Refrigerators - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY FEES APPLY** - Must be empty of food and must stand the refrigerator upright when removing from your vehicle.

Roofing tiles - **FEES APPLY Inert Waste Rate** - Used and clean concrete and clay roof tile (no wood, tar paper, or trash), **Solid Waste Rate** - New concrete and clay roof tile, or used tile that is mixed with wood, tar paper or trash.

S

Septic waste ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED** - call the landfill prior to hauling for acceptance criteria

Sharps - **ACCEPTED** - (sharps, including needles, lancets, test strips, etc).
(Pharmaceuticals) **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Shopping Carts - **NO** - Contact carTrac toll free at 1-888-992-4778 or (818) 817-6712. If carTrac issues a log as scrap value, then we can accept as clean scrap metal.

Smoke detectors, household - **ACCEPTED** - residents are encouraged to return them to the manufacturer for disposal due to certain smoke detectors containing small amounts of radioactive material. At this time, the county can accept them from residents since they are exempt from the regulations prohibiting disposal. Please pull out any recycle the battery.

Sod - **ACCEPTED** - mixtures of sod, dirt, weeds.

Soda Ash - **ACCEPTED** - **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Soil ([PDF](#)) - **ACCEPTED** - call the landfill prior to hauling for approval information.

Solar devices - **ACCEPTED** - vinyl pool solar heating systems - small units such as garden lights or calculators accepted daily at no charge through the E-waste program.

Solar panels - **NO** - High levels of lead and cadmium prohibit landfill disposal of panels. **ACCEPTED for a fee** - **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Steel cans - **ACCEPTED** - FREE RECYCLING - (Plastic, glass containers, aluminum cans, tin cans clean foil & trays, aseptic, juice box type containers) Must be rinsed, discard plastic lids & caps, no plastic bags of film wrap #1, #2, #5, and #7 okay. **Exclusions:** #6 - Styrofoam trays & carry out containers #4 - film plastics such as bags/plastic wrap #3 PVC pipe - DISPOSAL ONLY mirrors, window glass and light bulbs.

Stumps - **ACCEPTED** - for disposal only - tree rounds greater than 12" diameter and 12" in length.

Styrofoam - **ACCEPTED** - for disposal only - (#6 meat trays & carry-out containers, packing peanuts, or blocks) - for information on polystyrene recycling, call (800) 828-2214.

T

Tanning bed - **ACCEPTED** - fluorescent bulbs, ballasts and capacitors must be removed for acceptance. - items removed **ACCEPTED** - **Fridays and Saturdays** - during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. 3:30 p.m.**

Tiles, floor (ceramic, porcelain, stone) - **ACCEPTED** - daily for recycling

Tiles, roofing - (concrete, asphalt, wood with tar paper) - **ACCEPTED** - for disposal only

Tiles, vinyl - **ACCEPTED** - for disposal only

Tin cans - (see mixed recyclables)

Tire rims only - **ACCEPTED** - (metal scrap)

Tires (auto, truck, or motorcycle) - **ACCEPTED** - with or without rims - limit 9 without a permit

Tires (small) - **ACCEPTED** - free recycling (9 or less bicycle, wheelbarrow, go-cart) NO rims, Tubes and 10 or more tires subject to disposal fees.

Toilets/sinks - (porcelain - **ACCEPTED** - [FEES APPLY](#))

Toner/ink - **ACCEPTED** **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.**

Transmission fluid, [transmission oil](#) - **ACCEPTED**- free recycling

Trash compactors - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEES APPLY](#)

V

Vehicles - **NO** - See [DMV](#) website - How to Dispose of a Vehicle.... To donate your vehicle, see: DMV Website - Car Donations.

Vitamins - **ACCEPTED** - **Fridays and Saturdays** during the **Household Hazardous Waste** event from **7:30 a.m.** - **3:30 p.m.** - Liquid vitamins in large quantities, call the landfill prior to hauling.

W

Washers - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEE APPLY](#)

Water filtration unit - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEE APPLY](#) - water must be drained.

Water heaters - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEE APPLY](#)

Water softener - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEE APPLY](#) softener units and salts accepted for disposal.

Wood - **ACCEPTED EVERY DAY** - [FEE APPLY](#) - lumber, pallets, crating, fencing, trim plywood. Particleboard decking and other clean wood products.
