2020-2021 Community Action Plan Annual Review

The 2020-2021 Community Needs Assessment conducted by the Community Services Action Board (CSAB) identified four key areas of need in the community:

- 1. Housing & Homeless Services**
- 2. Income and Employment Assistance**
- 3. Emergency Assistance**
- 4. Disability Related or Elderly Services**

The list below shows data representing the successes of the five 2020-2021 CSBG Subcontracted providers and Yolo County HHSA's CSBG Funding for housing/homeless services from January 1st, 2021 through May 31st, 2022. The following funding sources are included: CSBG CARES, CSBG CARES Discretionary funds, 2021 Regular CSBG, and 2021 Regular CSBG Discretionary Funds.

Priority 1: Housing & Homeless Services

- 42 permanent housing placements
- 87 persons secured safe and affordable housing
- 456 individuals received emergency shelter
- 261 households avoided eviction

Priority 2: Income and Employment Assistance

- 38 individuals obtained employment up to a living wage
- 8 individuals obtained employment with a living wage or higher
- 16 individuals received on the job training and other work experience
- 58 individuals received assistance with resume development
- 12 individuals received financial coaching/counseling

Priority 3: Emergency Assistance

- 184 households received rent payments, including emergency rental payments
- 29 households received assistance with utility payments
- 215 prepared meals were provided
- 383 individuals received hygiene facility utilization services (e.g. showers, toilets, sinks)
- 20 individuals received legal assistance

Priority 4: Disability Related or Elderly Services

- 44 individuals over the age of 65 were served with CSBG funds
- 304 individuals with a disabling condition were served with CSBG funds
