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Executive Summary

The Rural Community Investment Program is an annual expenditure plan adopted by the Board of Supervisors that advances unaddressed programs, policies, and initiatives in rural unincorporated areas that meet one of two objectives: economic development or health and safety.

Capay Valley Resident Deputy Program

Agency: Yolo County Sheriff Department

Amount Awarded: \$200,000

Project: This project funded the Sheriff resident deputy program in Capay Valley, ensuring the safety and security of rural populations.





Madison-Knights Landing CSD Truck

Agency: Yolo County Department of Community Services

Amount Awarded: \$50,000

Project: This project funded the purchase of a replacement truck for the Madison and Knights Landing CSD. The truck was used for responding to customer complaints, waterline breaks, inspections, water quality, sampling for both wastewaters and drinking water, checking on facilities and log meter readings, simple repairs and maintenance of facilities.

Prop. 68 Rural Parks Grant Match

Agency: Yolo County Parks Department

Amount Awarded: \$65,000

Project: This project funded park improvements in the rural community.



Knights Landing Levee Project

Agency: Yolo County Administrator's Office

Amount Awarded: \$105,000

Project: This amount helped to leverage \$15.1 million in State Cost share to provide levee improvements to Knights Landing.



Guinda Town Hall Improvements

Agency: Yolo County Administrator's Office

Amount Awarded: \$5,000

Project: This project provided match funding for improvements to the Guinda Grange Hall kitchen flooring.



Rural Fire Districts Sustainability

Agency: Yolo County Administrator's Office

Amount Awarded: \$500,000

Project: This funding helped update the rural Fire District fee assessments to improve their fiscal condition (\$300K) and provide funding toward most critical and district personal protective equipment needs (\$200K).



Tuli Mem Park Operations & Maintenance

Agency: Yolo County Department of General Services

Amount Awarded: \$125,000

Project: This amount funded continued operations and maintenance of Tuli Mem Park located in Esparto.
