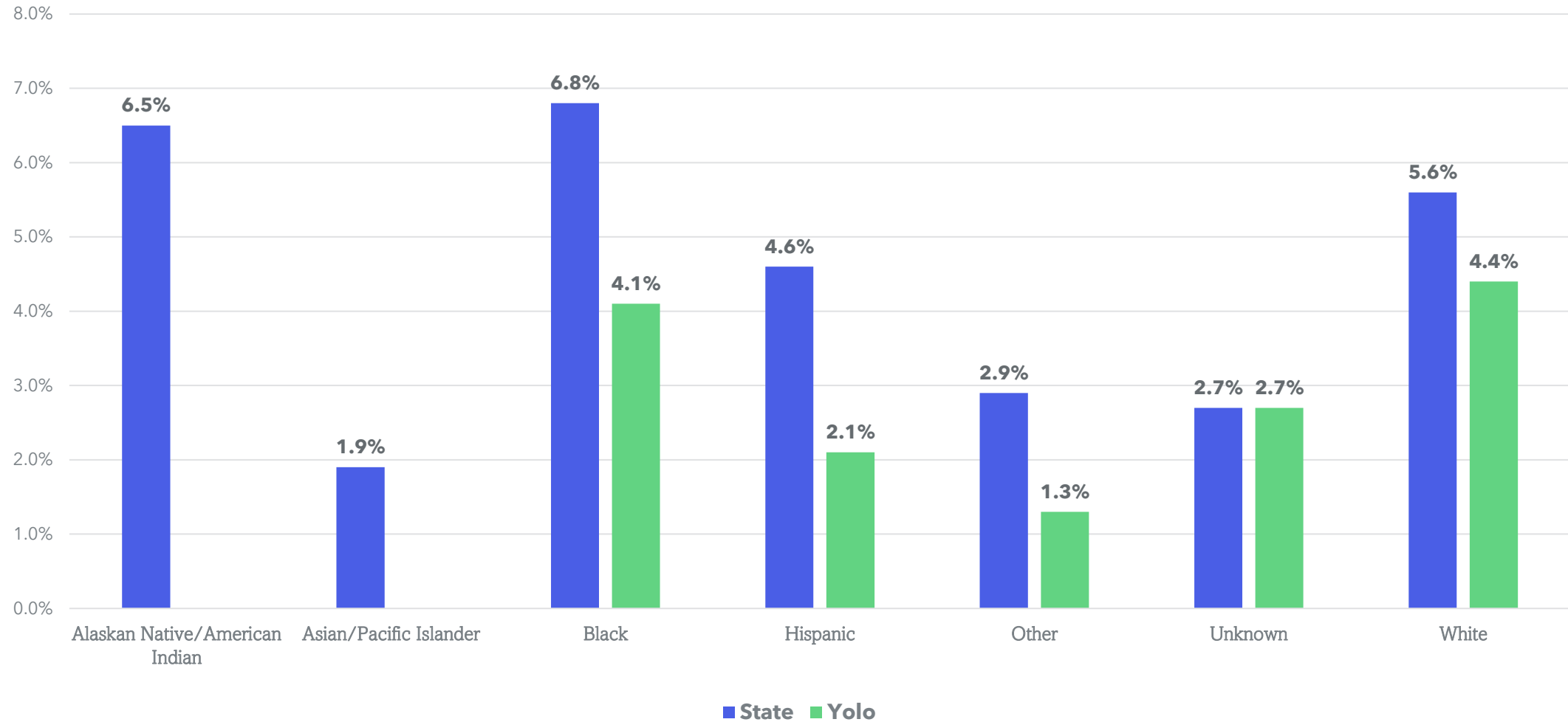

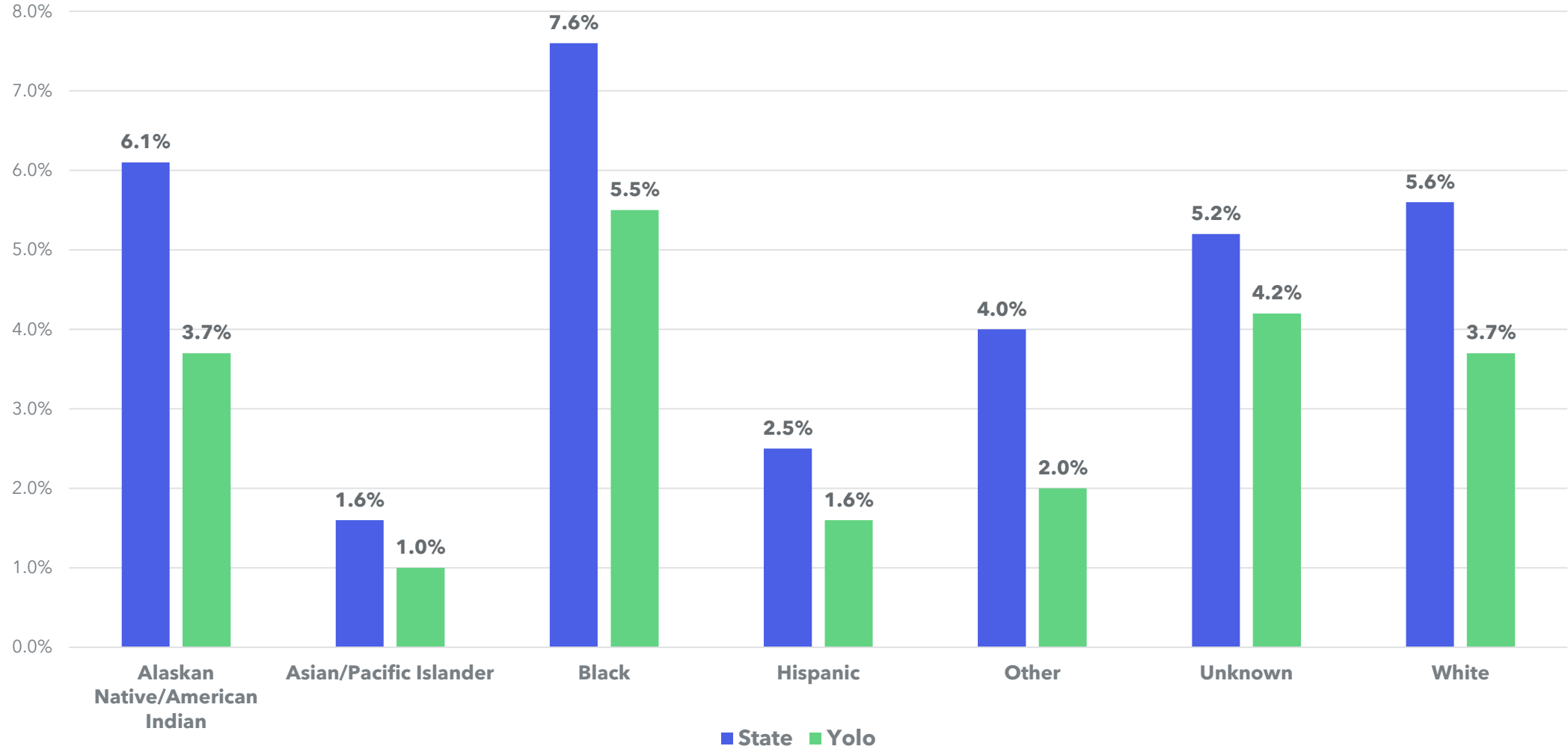

CHILD & YOUTH SMHS ACCESS RATES IN FY19-20: STATE VS. YOLO

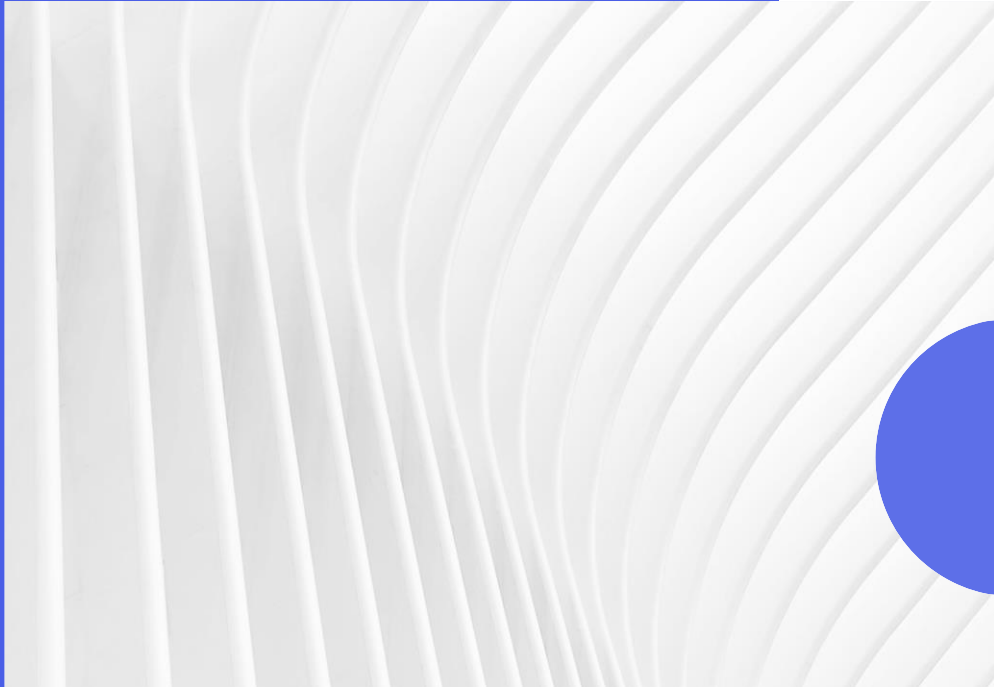


NOTE: missing data means it was suppressed for Yolo due to N being too small

FOSTER KIDS & CONGREGATE CARE

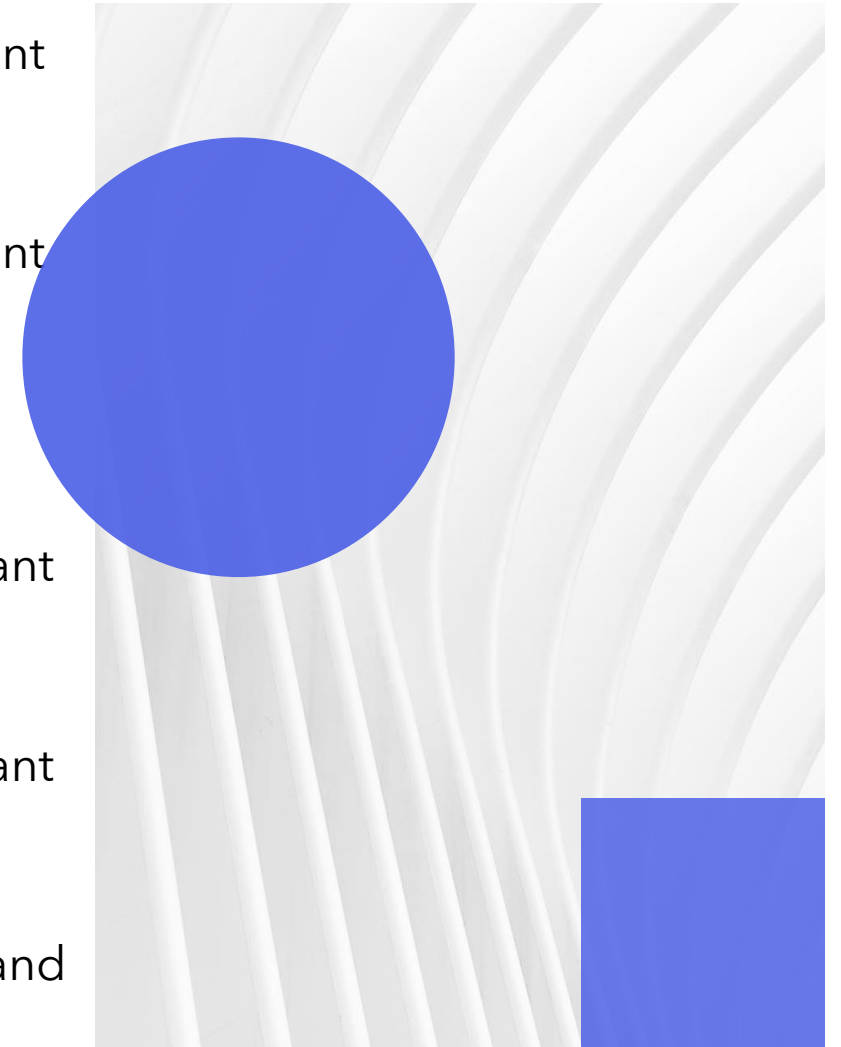


- ❖ 20 Unduplicated youth were placed in congregate care settings in Yolo County at some point during the 21-22 Fiscal Year

**COVID-19 PANDEMIC IMPACT ON
BEHAVIORIAL HEALTH SERVICES IN
YOLO COUNTY**

- ❖ Increased numbers of youth receiving services who reported significant levels of anxiety
- ❖ Increased numbers of youth receiving services who reported significant levels of major depression
- ❖ Decreased access/utilization of mental health services for youth
- ❖ Increased numbers of adults receiving services who reported significant levels of anxiety
- ❖ Increased numbers of adults receiving services who reported significant levels of major depression
- ❖ Increased Emergency Department visits related to misuse of alcohol and drugs among adults





**COVID-19 PANDEMIC IMPACT ON
YOLO COUNTY BEHAVIORIAL
HEALTH STAFFING**

- ❖ Staff redirected or reassigned to support Covid-19 teams
- ❖ Staff resignations
- ❖ Staff out to work care for family diagnosed with Covid-19
- ❖ Staff burnout

In response Yolo County has begun:

- ❖ Utilizing telework practices
- ❖ Allowing flexible work hours
- ❖ Hiring new staff
- ❖ Exploring increase salary for key classifications
