# **Inclusive Leadership Training**

#### Description

Engaging in equity work challenges us to face manifestations of historically-rooted and systemic social issues. Solving these inequities are particularly challenging because no one entity or person created the problem and no one person or entity can fix it. But everyone can develop the knowledge and skills to actively contribute to reducing inequities within their sphere of influence.

Workplaces are experiencing higher levels of conversations and conflict about social issues. Strong skilled leadership in navigating these conversations and conflict is needed more than ever. This session challenges leaders to assess their capacity for risk and vulnerability as we navigate this complex yet rewarding conversation.

The interactive, skills-based training program offered by Tangible Development will equip participants with the understanding, language and skills needed to engage in social issues and lead their staff as inclusive leaders committed to creating a welcoming and productive work environment.

## **Session Learning Outcomes**

In this session participants will:

- Examine tangible steps needed to integrate DEI work into the operational structure of Yolo County.
- Establish a common foundation and shared language for DEI work at Yolo County, including socializing Yolo's newly established DEI Commitment statement.
- Reflect and describe how their social identities impact how they show up as leaders.
- Understand how social identities impact power dynamics and relationships in the workplace.
- Evaluate opportunities and threats for adopting DEI best practices as leaders.
