- Call to Order The meeting was called to order by Scott Picanso. Committee members
 present were Mark Ulrich, Doug Williams, Georgia Cochran, Joan Kingery and Rick
 Fenaroli. Also present was Kim Villa from the CSA Administrative Support Team, Lachi
 Richards, Dottie Prichard from the Supervisor's Office, and Fernando from SUSP as well
 as members of community.
- 2. Introductions: None
- 3. Public Comment: None
- 4. Approval of Minutes from June 1, 2022. Moved and seconded to approve minutes.
- 5. Report from Supervisor Sandy's Office: Dottie, none from Supervisor.
- 6. Discussion and Action Items
 - a. Report out from Golf Sub-Advisory Committee meeting (Picanso): Open forum, golf course condition, need to aerate more frequently and aggressively, large crowd expressing dissatisfaction with condition. Joe Smith is new supervisor and Jason Deubler is course superintendent. Mark, need to work hard to improve the golf course with management of Kemper, and devote resources to improve. Approval rating dropped from 8.5 to 5.5.
 - b. Welcome of Rick Fenaroli to Advisory committee, from HOA.
 - c. Update on Pintail Pump Lowering (County): Grant for \$3.8million. Includes lowering of Pintail pump, will be done in Winter months when less water demand. Eight bidders attended the preconstruction site walk but only one bid was submitted., could be up to 100 feet lower. Presently Pintail is at 465 feet. Can only pump 850 down from 1,200 gpm. Hoping to get to 600 feet. Could possibly treat Canvasback water for arsenic with Wood Duck well. Could possibly put arsenic treatment at Pintail.
 - d. **Update on New Well site. (County)** Out to bid for new well at Wood Duck, no tank required. Timeline is ordering parts in October or November and drilling in December 2022, then engineering for the other pieces of the well system, environmental study is being done, CEQA.
 - e. Update on water and wastewater operations (SUSP) Fernando Handout in Attachment 1: New water meters starting this Friday -Monday. No water from Canvasback, Pintail @ 9.1 million gallons/month. No major issues with water or wastewater. Georgia, explain new smart meters, then software to notify homeowners. Fernando will install meter, then program to show what water consumption, and how to download to homeowner this information. Kim, needs to get out an RFP for the appropriate water billing system, hopefully online.

- f. Current status of wells/water levels (County)Lachi Pintail starting to flatten out, 110 feet above shutoff level, Ok for remainder of this season with a 36% savings in water. Canvasback level is at same, have ~ 50 feet of water left. Comment that a large number of orchards that use water. Scott, uses Penterra, for his lawn which reduces water use.
- g. **Update on Water Meters (County)** New water meters starting this Friday Monday, will be installed on all houses, need 5 min/house to shut off water. Kim, replacing old meters that are worn out. Engineers study to determine new water use charging system will be coming Georgia, need accurate meters to tell high water users that they need to cut back, and use billing system to conserve.
- h. Update on CSA financials and Action Plan (County) year is still open, some invoices are still outstanding. Did not get greens mower yet, will be paid out of last year. Last sewer loan payment will be next year, ~\$250/household. Kim, received Watt airport connection payment, water budget will not show grant payment yet. Insurance premium is \$141,000 for lawsuit, for a 5-year period and one more year to go. Projected golf fund balance will be \$273,000, have spent \$20,000 to repair leaks in last couple of months. Why do we have so many leaks? Lachi commented that leaks are at seams and bends, needs better valves to eliminate air hammer. Rick- could get stress fractures from dried-out condition of course, Rainbird sprinklers also failing, due to age of equipment. Need Rainbird sprinklers, individually controlled, which are connected to the Rainbird controller.
