

#### FY 2021-2022 Referrals


- 189 Participants were referred to AIC/MHC
- 30 of those participants were re-referred to AIC/MHC
- 6 out of those 30 were accepted
- Out of 76 referrals, 12 were accepted into MHC/JMHC(15.8% acceptance rate/total of 36 participants for the FY)
- Out of 103 referrals, 12 were accepted into AIC (11.7% acceptance rate/total of 37 participants for the FY)
- 10 Participants not met with as of 7/1/22 (5 MHC, 5 AIC)






#### MHC Outcomes for Current Participants






Participants had a 92.8% reduction of jail bed days while in the program





#### **DSH Hospitalizations**







#### **Local Hospitalizations:**

- o Days for participants that opted out= 100% reduction






#### MHC Jail Bed Comparison of Exited Participants




**# Of Bed Days For All Participants**







#### # Of Arrests 1 Year Prior & 1 Year Post Dismissal




## # Of Jail Bed Days Prior To Entry & Post Exit of AIC
