Protocols:

Acute Cerebral Vascular Accident:

UPDATED: To include BE-FAST Standards

Altered Level of Consciousness:

UPDATED: Naloxone dose to 0.4 mg titrated to respiratory effect

Medical Cardiac Arrest:

UPDATED: Sustained ROSC for transport

Pain Management:

UPDATED: Removal of IN Ketamine

UPDATED: Wording of IV Ketamine max dosing

Post Resuscitation Care:

UPDATED: Do NOT divert if patient re-arrests. Continue to STEMI Receiving Center.

Tachycardia with Pulses

UPDATED: Synchronized Cardioversion to read Use ACLS recommended energy dose.

Trauma Patient Care:

UPDATED: to include time change to Time of Incident to ER greater than 20 minutes (not just transport time).
