### **LOW INCOME DISCOUNTS\***

Any single-family customer household that has been authorized for low income assistance by Yolo County may qualify for a twenty percent (20%) discount

#### **ASSISTED SERVICE\***

Disabled residents who have applied for Assisted Service through Yolo County and have been authorized for such collection will receive the following—drivers shall walk up, retrieve carts from garage or fence line, service carts, and return carts to original location.

### **SENIOR AND DISABLED BULKY WASTE COLLECTION**

Single-family customers in a household where all inhabitants are 65 years of age or older, or have a disability can receive up to two Bulky Waste Collection service events per year at the curbside at no extra charge to the customer.

### **BULKY WASTE LANDFILL COUPON**

Each single-family household and multi-family residential unit will receive a landfill coupon in May and October valid for the entire calendar month. Each landfill coupon entitles the customer up to one full-size pickup load of trash, which may include up to two bulky items. Maximum three feet high and eight feet long.
