a. SB 1383 Food Rescue Update - Marissa Juhler

- Yolo County has officially signed an agreement with the Yolo Food Bank and has released their
 first payment. The Esparto Countryside church has also signed an agreement with Yolo County.
 Which starts us on the right path with edible food recovery.
- Yolo County will be tabling the Technical Advisory Committee "TAC". We will reassess this committee in 2023.

b. Member Update

Yolo County - Marissa Juhler

• Every October, Yolo County turns in the 303 report to the state. This report itemizes the hazardous waste that is collected in each jurisdiction. Total from all jurisdictions and the hazardous waste facility was 9,422. The total of participants was 13,976 which is up from last year.

Yolo County - Ramin Yazdani

- The newly constructure landfill module (WMU H) was just opened for waste acceptance. Thanks to Jeff Kieffer and his staff.
- Contractor is making good progress in reconstruction of leachate pond waste (WMUG).
 Completion is expected to be earlier than scheduled time in November 2022.
- Early November2022, the food depackager will be operational and seeding of the in-vessel digester will begin.
- County has signed agreements for organic waste for City of Davis and City of West Sacramento and is currently waiting for final version from City of Woodland. County is waiting for City of Winters.
