





Goals

Goal: “A broad statement about what you want to achieve”

Creating a meaningful goal:

- Broad (aspirational), future oriented statement
- Defines scope of achievement (who do you want to impact in what way)
- Provides framework for objectives



1. All children and youth in Yolo County thrive in healthy educational, play & care environments

“What does *Healthy* mean in this goal” “What Risk Behavior is being addressed?”

Rewrite suggestion: All children and youth in Yolo County should have the opportunity to thrive and be healthy.

Discussion, Comments, Edits...

How does this encompass youth? +1 (period of time between childhood and adult age - was initially added, support use of using only “youth”)

When think of common term youth don't think of children (support keeping both words) +3 (work for youth homelessness youth is 8-20, so children is good to keep) (really different needs)

Gives better idea using children + youth

What risk behavior is being addressed? No indication that it's a risk behavior could easily be service environment also.

No opposition to rewrite suggestion.



2. All residents of Yolo County experience barrier and stigma free awareness and care for substance use disorders and related risk behaviors

“What is meant by awareness: awareness of services? of SUD?”

“Mental health feels left out of this goal, does it fit in somehow”

“Wording and position of *barrier* is difficult to understand intent”

“similar to goal 4”

Rewrite suggestion: Equitable and stigma free access to care for mental health, substance use disorders and related risk behaviors.

Discussion, Comments, Edits...

Distinction b/w SUDs and MH – like how it’s written, MH & BH are sort of the same but should be kept separate in goal – shared understanding will help in PH & BH to work together

Can touch on access barriers, getting treatment, and other barriers in #4 to distinguish from #2

Focus is on residents’ experience which is different than access – two different aspects of the challenge. Not as much in favor of rewrite – takes focus away from residents’ experience



3. Every child who interacts with the foster care system will be placed in an environment that supports their health and growth

“Important to engage foster youth for addressing if selected - ensuring representative input and voice”

Should we include youth?

Suggestion: every child and youth who interacts... +1 (all children and youth)

Only addresses foster youth in system there are other youth who are justice-involved; is it only specific to foster care? (juvenile-dependency system, homeless youth - how embody all of them?) [may be too broad to include all]



4. Equitable and stigma free access to mental and behavioral health care is available to all Yolo County Residents

"use of *Equitable* and *available to all* seems duplicative - can we select one phrase"


“Looking for clarity – early detection, intervention, treatment...of what”



Breakout: Brainstorming Objectives





Objectives

Objective: “Statements about what your work, efforts or actions are intended to accomplish/achieve and how.”

Note: You often will need more than one objective to address a single goal.

Example:

- “By the end of 2023, 65% of the county’s youth are consuming the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables”
- “By August 2024, there will be an increase in the number of elementary age students in Yolo County who eat at least 5 servings of fruits and vegetables per day from 30% to 60%”

Goal Selected: County residents experience equitable and stigma free access to care for mental health, substance use disorders and related risk behaviors.

Example Objective: *“By the end of 2023, 65% of the county’s youth are consuming the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables”*

- Brainstorm here
 - Informed by good data, can help to break down silos
 - Need understanding of cross-cultural approaches and communication to keep folks engaged (stigma approach; consider linguistic isolation - difficult to reach Russian speaking population)
 - Yolo County will create a public-facing portal to access current data re: mental health, substance use, and related risk behaviors.
 - Refugee populations - many don't speak English, don't know how to access resources or who to speak to
 - Migrants coming in different times of year to do farm work
 - One side provider; community side - stigma; provider training or community side
 - Russian / Latin speaking community - need to get system language to the side
 - Bullying - dispute resolution counselor, need an outlet; can approach person in county and explain their issue; allowing bullied folks to have an outlet
 - Individual outside the system who can receive and issue and not be tied to agency

Goal Selected: County residents experience equitable and stigma free access to care for mental health, substance use disorders and related risk behaviors.

Example Objective: "By the end of 2023, 65% of the county's youth are consuming the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables"

- Brainstorm here
 - Yolo Conflict Resolution Center engaged - considering how to allow that space for community members to have issues addressed in trauma informed way
 - Providing harm reduction services, not solely focused on cessation for SUDs
 - Increase system engagement/collaboration to be holistic
 - The use of "language brokers" or "cultural ambassadors" during COVID was helpful. It would be great if this was a county standard in agency outreach.
 - How to work with youth population? Have MH support in conjunction with HHSA, Communicare, Education, support at school sites; have more funding to support as needed; ongoing issue

Goal Selected: All families and individuals in Yolo County have equitable access to preventive and primary health & wellness services.

Example Objective: *“By the end of 2023, 65% of the county’s youth are consuming the recommended amount of fruits and vegetables”*

- Yolo county residents to be aware of services that are currently available (shared from housing services)
- Access to quality services - some services people receive would not be considered 'quality', not enough providers in general
- Access for farm workers, job leave to get services is not available “sick time”, transportation issues
- Need more culturally aligned, competent and understanding navigation for services - build off of successful model - Promotoras(es)
 - Increase numbers in county to support.
 - Technical Assistance can be provided too for wrap around needs
- Timely services needed, delayed follow-up, skipping appointments.
- Do we need to define “wellness” – drawing on SDoH and whole person care
- Need number for all resources “one stop shop” (example: for aging resource line)
- CHW benefit growth and inclusion in more organizations (education around building network, billing, etc...). Helping organizations know how to use and integrate
