Rescission of the Amended Mass Isolation Order of the Yolo County Public Health Officer

Effective March 1, 2023 at 12:01 am, the Amended Mass Isolation Order of the Yolo County Public Health Officer is rescinded.

Isolation refers to the separation of persons infected with a contagious disease, in this case COVID-19, from people who are not infected.

Once the rescission is in effect, all persons in Yolo County are advised to follow isolation instructions provided by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and California Department of Social Services (CDSS). These instructions include, but are not limited to:
