4. Regular Agenda

a. SB 1383 Food Rescue Update - Marissa Juhler

- Yolo County along with a representative from each city toured the Food Bank and had our 6month check-in with them. Since our last visit a lot of progress has taken place. We were able to meet the whole team.
- The cities and the county will be getting back together to discuss what we would like to budget for year two of the Edible Food Recovery program. We will also be meeting with the other pantries as well.

 We are on track together around 80,000 lbs of new material. A piece of SB 1383 where we can see tangible results.

b. Member Updates - Yolo County - Marissa Juhler

- Update on Solar Project Last month I reported on a solar project that will be implemented this fall out on our borrow site along CR 104. This month, I am reporting on a second solar project that was in the works to evaluate whether solar should be installed on top of our landfill cells. The two proposals received were from Ameresco and Laketricity both of which are still under review with our Financial Services department. We are also waiting to hear back from references, such as San Joaquin County, who are using one of these vendors at one of their waste facilities. I would like to thank Dave Powell for sitting on the review committee for this project. It is still yet to be determined if this project will proceed forward.
- Staffing Updates The recruitment for a new Division Director will close tomorrow, 2/24/23 with
 interviews to follow the first or second week in March. Additionally, we are in the process of
 backfilling 4 vacancies. (Solid Waste Attendant, Waste Facility Worker, Senior Civil Engineer, and
 Supervising Solid Waste Attendant position). These are all being slated for the FYU 23-24
 budget, which I will share with the WAC next month. (See updated org chart)
- There was a request for us to explain the process of how the depackager works and how the material flows to our in-vessel digester. Since we do not have a drawing of this start to finish process, I was going to see if everyone is interested in just getting a tour of the depacker at the March WAC meeting or I can simply have one of the engineers start drawing up something to share with you all in March. (Notes for minutes: WAC gave a thumbs up to touring the depackager and learning the IVD process. Marissa to arrange for March/April or May)

City of Davis – Richard Tsai

- This week is City of Davis' last week of the fall/winter loose yard material collection season. The next loose yard material collection will be during the week of May 1.
- Davis had the annual CalRecycle conference call last week to check in on solid waste diversion laws. CalRecycle was pleased current progress.
- All Davis' Tier 1 food generators are in contract with the Yolo Food Bank and are recovering
 edible food. Now staff is working to ensure that they are collecting the maximum amount of
 recoverable food.
