Vice Chair Artie Lawyer will lead a discussion of the current status of yard trimmings collection in Old Willowbank, with comparisons to other nonincorporated and incorporated areas of Yolo County. The discussion will be aimed at enabling an exploratory process in which Old Willowbank can determine what viable options, if any, are available for yard trimmings collection under the current agreement with the County. repair alternative, discussed extensively at the January 24th WCSA meeting.
Committee Member Brian Morrisey will provide a preliminary overview of a
Proposed project undergrounding overhead utilities throughout the neighborhood.
Morrisey will discuss what he anticipates would be the major benefits as well as the anticipated hurdles involved. If the Committee agrees, it is expected that Morrisey will return at the May 16th meeting with a recommendation for further study or a
