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REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) – "REUSE SHED" CARGO CONTAINER

Artists' Design PROPOSALS DUE APRIL 15, 2023

The Yolo County Division of Integrated Waste Management is pleased to release a call to artists to paint a mural on our "Reuse Shed" Cargo Container located at the Yolo County Central Landfill at 44090 County Road 28H, Woodland, CA. We are seeking an artist to paint murals on 2 sides of the cargo container that is used as a storage and "shopping" container for reusable paint. Pictures and dimensions of the cargo container can be found in Exhibit A. Artists shall submit one (1) design idea. The selected artist will have 30 days to complete the work.

Before award, the proposal and design will be reviewed and approved by a committee with representatives from the Meeting of Area Recycling Coordinators, the Yolo County Waste Advisory Committee, PaintCare, the Division of Integrated Waste Management, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors and YoloArts.

BUDGET

A \$5,000.00 stipend, sponsored by PaintCare, will be awarded to the selected artist for the painting of the cargo container. The stipend shall cover all artist costs associated with the design and installation of the artwork, including supplies, and all required insurance (See Exhibit C), taxes, etc. Any paint used from the paint shed will be provided at no cost to the artist. One half of the stipend will be paid prior to beginning the work. The remaining stipend will be paid after the work is completed. Work shall begin within 14 days of the award and shall be completed no more than 30 days after work commences.

DESIGN PARAMETERS

- Design will be consistent with the Yolo County Landfill's mission to promote environmental protection and service to our community. (www.yolocounty.org) Click on the Trash and Recycling tab.
- Design will be consistent with PaintCare's mission to provide easy and convenient access to recycle and reuse paint. (www.paintcare.org) Search by State for California specific information.
- Themes for the mural could include nature scenes, the environment, an ecosystem. Using the earth and the recycling symbol are also good additions
- Incorporation of reusable paints from the paint shed and/or the use of Visions of Sacramento remanufactured paint are highly encouraged. (www.visionsqualitycoatings.com)
- Designs should be quality works of art and should appeal to a broad constituency.
- The verbiage "Free Paint and other Reusable Products Available Here" should be incorporated into the mural. It is preferred but not required that the PaintCare and Yolo County Recycles logos (See Exhibit B)

are also incorporated into the mural. If an artist does not choose to incorporate the logos into their artwork, a 1 ft. x 2 ft. space needs to be left blank on side 2 of the cargo container so that the County can purchase and incorporate a plaque near the main roll up door/entrance to recognize the partnership and funding source.

- Proposed artwork cannot contain copyrighted or trademarked images, brand names, or work copied from another source.
- The artwork included on the application must closely resemble the art to be painted on the container.
- Mural shall be all-weather for a metal surface.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply, please submit one electronic copy of the complete proposal to ccallahan@yolocounty.org and shall include the following:

- 1. Artist's Proposal. Conceptual design drawings sufficient to communicate the artist's concept. Drawings shall be in color and shall be provided for 2 sides of the cargo container. The photos should be high resolution image(s).
- 2. Artist's Statement. Artist's statement which includes a description of the proposed artwork and how it relates to the identified themes.
- 3. Two examples of past work (if applicable).

4. Artist's contact information.
