## **Community Invited to Free Gardening Basics Class on April 19**

**(Woodland, CA)** – Spring is around the corner and it's time to dust off your gardening tools and begin preparing for a spring and summer garden. Yolo County residents are invited to learn about gardening basics with Treva Valentine, a UC Master Gardener, on Wednesday, April 19, from 5:15 to 6:30 p.m. at the Hanna & Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden in Woodland.

This free, interactive class is presented by the Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) and will cover topics such as soil preparation, strategies for planting and timing for planting summer crops. There will also be time to ask questions. No gardening experience is required to attend.

This class is available to all and is part of HHSA's commitment to providing education to help residents eat more fresh fruits and vegetables and live healthier lives.
