CHIP Geographical Data Comparison Sheets

(Woodland, CA) – The CHIP Geographical Data Comparison Sheets highlight differences in health, including health behaviors and services, across Yolo County. The purpose of these sheets is to support the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP) workgroup and, the Yolo County residents and community partners at large, in understanding and addressing poor health outcomes and health disparities. The data sheets focus on the two priority areas chosen by the CHIP workgroup: risk behaviors and service environment.

Five geographical areas are represented: Davis, West Sacramento, Woodland, Winters, and Unincorporated/Rural Areas. Data displayed on the Geographical Data Comparison Sheets were collected from various state and national databases, and data from within Yolo County. These include Ed Data, CDC PLACES Project, Healthy Places Index, Kids Data, Open Justice, U.S Census, and Walk Score.

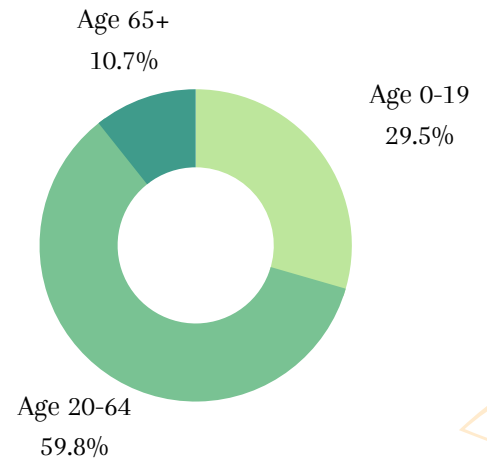

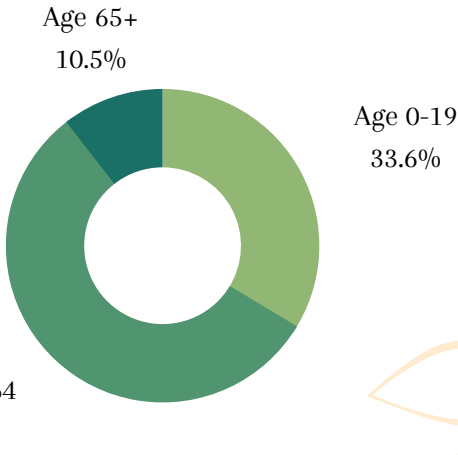
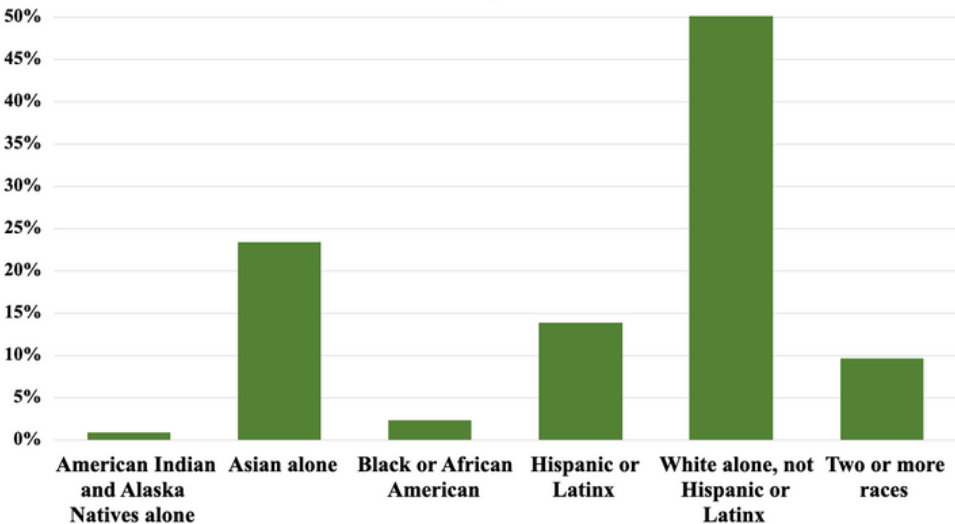

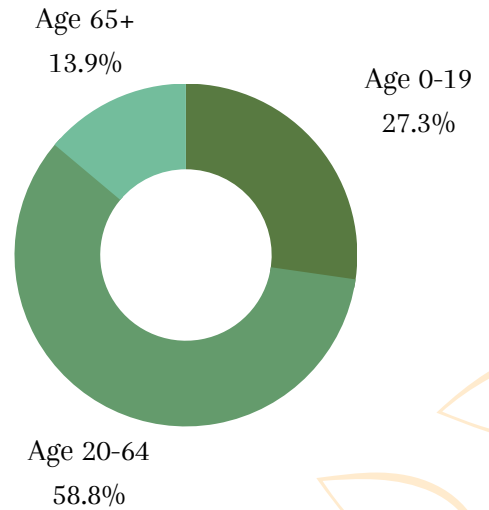
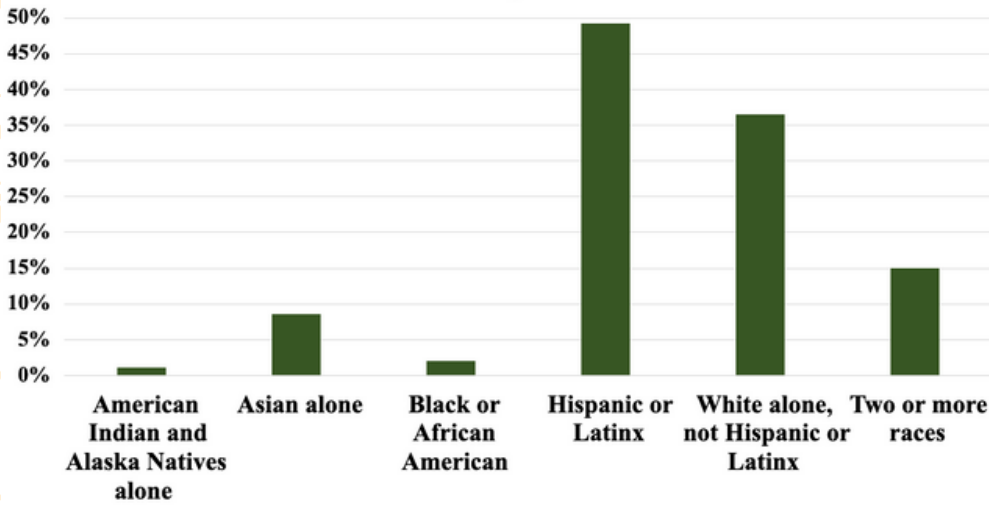

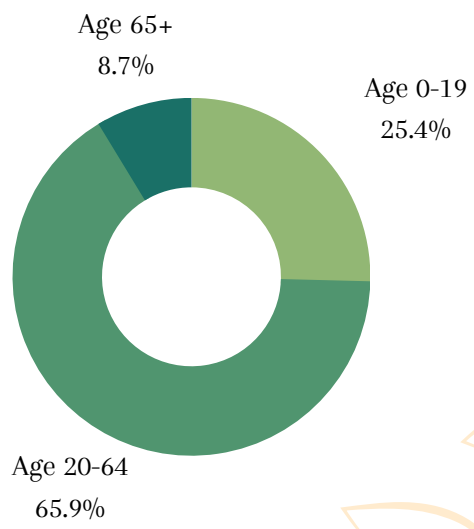
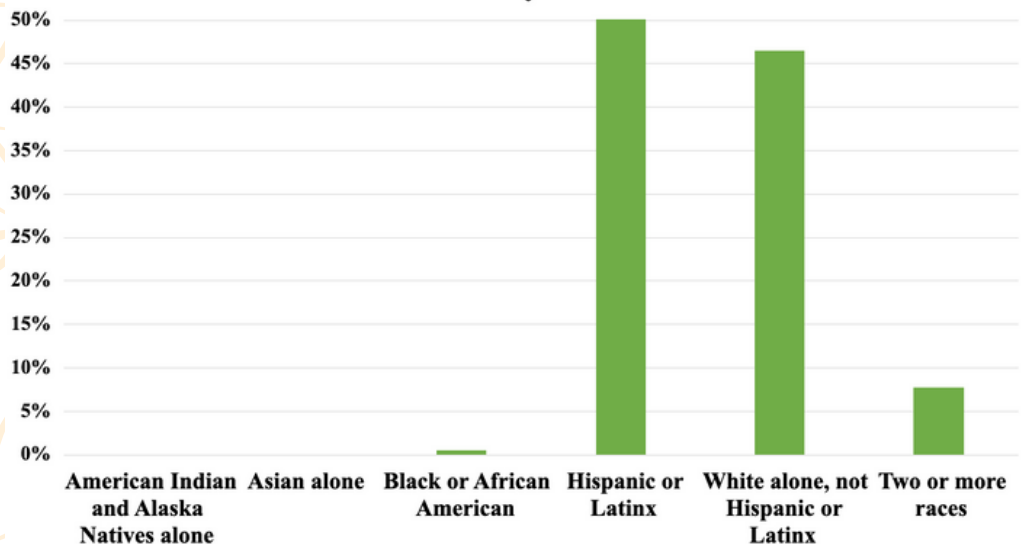

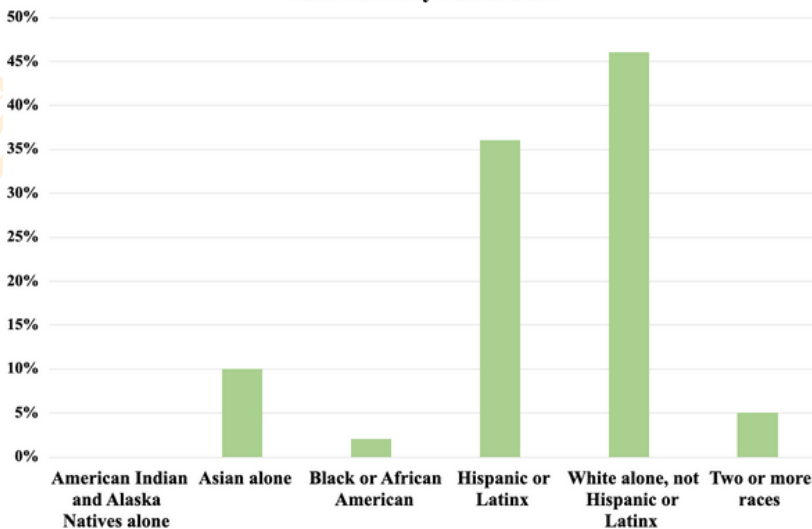

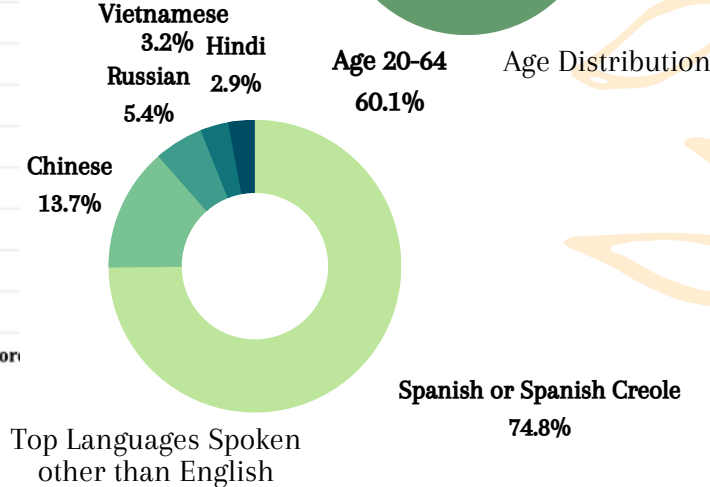

Data Appendix

Median Household Income: Income in the past 12 months in households in 2021 ²

Median Gross Rent: provides information on the monthly housing cost expenses (rent and average monthly cost of utilities) for renters from 2017-2021 ²

Obesity: # of adults with obesity (a BMI of at least 30.0 kg/m²) in 2018 ⁴

Physical Health Not Good: % of adults who felt their physical health was not good during 2 or more weeks of the previous month in 2018 ⁴

No Leisure Time Physical Activity: % of people who do not participate in physical activities, outside of their regular job in 2018 ⁴

Mental Health No Good: % of adults who felt their mental health was not good during 2 or more weeks of the previous month ⁴

Insured Adults: % of adults aged 18 to 64 years with health insurance in 2019 ⁴

Chlamydia and Gonorrhea Cases: # of new cases in 2022 per 100,000 residents ⁹

Current Smoker: % of adults who currently smoke in 2018 ⁴

Binge Drinking: % of adults who drank 5 or more alcoholic drinks (men) or 4 or more alcoholic drinks (women) at least once within the past month in 2018 ⁴

Depression-Related Feeling in 7th Graders: % of public-school students who felt so sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more from 2017-2019 ⁶

Chronic Absenteeism in Schools: % of students who have missed more than 10% of school in the 2020-21 school year ³

Homeownership: % of people who own their home in 2017 ⁴

Unhoused Individuals: # of people experiencing homelessness on a single night per 10,000 residents.

Violence: # of violent crimes reported by the police department for 2021 per 100,000 residents ⁷

CalFresh: households that use CalFresh services point-in-time per 100,000 residents (December 2022) ⁹

Top Three Languages: top languages spoken aside from English in 2020 ⁹

Dental Care in the Past Year: % of visits to the dentist or dental clinic in the previous year among adults aged 18 years or older ¹

Preventative Services, 65+: % of adults aged 65 and old who are up to date on a core set of clinical preventative services ¹

Walk Score: is a # between 0 and 100 that measures the walkability of any address ⁸

Transit Score: is a # between 0 and 100 that measures how well a location is served by public transit ⁸

Bike Score: is a # between 0 and 100 that measures whether an area is good for biking ⁸
