



Buprenorphine Online Training

Prehospital Buprenorphine for ALS providers

Mandatory online training:

- 45-minute video
- Pass post-test (20 questions) with at least 80%. If you do not pass, you must re-watch the video and retake the test.

This mandatory online training must be completed prior to attending Yolo County ALS Updates classes in May 2023.

Both the online Buprenorphine training and in-person ALS Updates class must be successfully completed to maintain current Yolo County Paramedic Accreditation.

1-hour of CEU for the online training will be provided following the ALS Updates class.
