Input Sought on Service Priorities for Low Income Populations Survey deadline extended to April 26

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Community Services Action Board has extended the deadline to provide input on how to better address the needs of low-income individuals and families that reside in Yolo County. Surveys can now be submitted through Wednesday, April 26.

Feedback provided by the community will help establish service priorities for the 2024-25 Community Services Block Grant funding cycle. Examples of services currently funded by the grant in Yolo County include emergency food and shelter, homeless prevention and housing related services.
