COVID-19 Vaccine Availability in Yolo County

(Woodland, CA) – Due to limited resources and dwindling demand associated with the conclusion of COVID-19 emergency declarations, Yolo County Health and Human Services' Public Health Branch is announcing the discontinuation of its COVID-19 vaccination clinics for the general public. Yolo County's free COVID-19 vaccination clinics in West Sacramento and Woodland will end this month, along with the free in-home COVID-19 vaccination program known as DoorVax. Residents are encouraged to get vaccinated for free at an upcoming clinic if they have not already received their COVID-19 vaccination. The remaining clinic schedule is as follows:

• June 16 - 3:00-6:00 PM - 137 N. Cottonwood St., Woodland

• June 29 – 3:00-6:00 PM – 500 Jefferson St., West Sacramento

• June 29 – Discontinuation of the in-home vaccination program. To schedule an in-home vaccination today, please call (530) 902-3230 for English or (530) 312-4139 for Spanish.

Vaccination against COVID-19 can benefit everyone aged 6 months and older. To be considered up-to-date with vaccination, individuals 6 years and older should have received a single dose of the bivalent/updated vaccine. Individuals who are immunocompromised or 65 years and older should receive two doses of the bivalent vaccine. Children under 6 years of age require multiple vaccine doses to be up-to-date; please consult your child's healthcare provider to determine their vaccination status.

The discontinuation of the clinics does not diminish the importance of COVID-19 vaccination. "COVID-19 has not gone away," says Dr. Aimee Sisson, Yolo County Public Health Officer. "Vaccination remains the best protection against severe COVID-19. If you or your loved ones have not received COVID vaccines, please visit a clinic this month and get vaccinated for free." Following the closure of County-run clinics, COVID-19 vaccines will still be available at retail pharmacies, healthcare provider offices, and community clinics.
