Subject: Organic material acceptance guidelines for SB 1383 reporting

Under the Recordkeeping Requirements of California Senate Bill (SB) 1383, it is required that each jurisdiction provide the California Department of Recourse, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) information related to the facilities the jurisdictions use to meet their organics diversion needs. The following information may be used for purposes of complying with Section 18984.1 to 18984.4:

As part of the Yolo County Central Landfill (57-AA-0001), there are three sub-permitted facilities for organic material processing. The RDRS Number for all three of these facilities is RD 12535
