Private Applicator Certificate (PAC) Revised Standards Training and Testing

This training will cover the new Private Applicator Certificate knowledge standards. In addition, we will cover burrowing vertebrate fumigation certification topics. The new PAC exam, as well as the Burrowing Vertebrate subcategory exam, will be offered at the end of the training.

This course qualifies for two CE hours*. Individuals required to obtain the new PAC must take and pass the exam to receive the CE hours.

NOTE: If you wish to continue to use aluminum phosphide (Phostoxin) to control burrowing rodents, one individual associated with the permit must take and pass the new PAC exam, as well as the burrowing vertebrate (BV) subcategory exam. The PAC holder, with the BV subcategory, will be responsible for supervising the fumigation per labeling requirements.
