## Yolo County Child Welfare Services: Data Snapshot September 2023

Yolo County Child Welfare Services (CWS) provides a variety of care services for youth in need. Open cases in CWS mean that a youth can be receiving services in one or more of the following programs: emergency response, family maintenance, and foster care (also known as out of home placement).

Data is provided below showing the total number of youth with an open case in CWS in Yolo County at a specific point in time and the program in which they are served. Additional data, including statewide information, is available from the UC Berkeley, California Child Welfare Indicators Project (<a href="https://ccwip.berkeley.edu/">https://ccwip.berkeley.edu/</a>). Due to the daily fluctuation in cases and slight alterations in methodologies, it is important to note that small variations in the data may exist between sources.
