PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

The purpose of this meeting is to provide information to the public and to give opportunity for public comments regarding a Permit Exemption Application submitted. The Permit Exemption process is described in Title 27 California Code of Regulations (CCR) Sections 21563-21565.5. The meeting is strictly informational, and no official decision is made at the meeting regarding the formal determination. The LEA may grant a Permit Exemption after a public meeting is conducted.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On February 2, 2023, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received a Permit Exemption Application Package. The applicant is proposing to remove the solid waste predominantly in the form of Precipitated Calcium Carbonate

(PCC) from the existing closed Spreckels Woodland Landfill (SWIS #57-AA-0020) to the project location. PCC is a biproduct from sugar beet processing; it is proposed to be blended with native soil and reused as engineered fill for future commercial buildings in the project location. The applicant is requesting the project location be exempt from the requirement of obtaining a Solid Waste Facility Permit.


If the Permit Exemption is granted, an approved Clean Closure Plan will be required prior to relocating the existing closed landfill material as per Title 27, CCR.
